Academic Counseling

General academic counseling & tutoring services to all recruited student-athletes. The department of athletics and the institution's student support services provide these services.

Champs/Life Skills Programs

NCAA Champs/Life Skills programs (or an equivalent program) are on going through the SAAC. Direct any student-athlete curious about programs to contact their SAAC representative on their team.

HOT STUFF – Neither MSU athletics nor you may pay for the following:

- Typing costs, course supplies (e.g., calculators, art supplies) & the use of a copy machine, fax machines or telephone. These are considered extra benefits and are a violation of NCAA rules.

THIS LIST IS NOT INCLUSIVE – ASK BEFORE YOU ACT!

YOU MAY NOT:

1. Type papers for student-athletes.
2. Save student-athlete work on your diskettes and or store it for them. They must retain their work.
3. Meet with student-athletes to perform work outside of study-hall times and locations without the written consent of your study-hall supervisor.
4. ACT contrary to any of the above Nonpermissible academic services listed above.
5. Contact Faculty or staff on behalf of student-athletes.

The work that you do and the interactions that you have may affect eligibility of our student-athletes either positively or negatively. The NCAA considers you an institutional staff member. You must report the following to the study hall supervisor regularly:

- A. All referrals you make.
- B. Inappropriate requests or pressures from student-athletes.
- C. Romantic or social involvement between tutors and student-athletes.
- D. Alleged or actual NCAA Rules violations.
- E. Any incident of academic fraud or of a suspicious nature academically.
- F. Extra benefits impermissibly given to student-athletes such as gifts, meals or transportation known to you.

Permissible Academic Services

YOU MAY:

- Tutor student-athletes.
- Counsel student-athletes regarding the treatment of eating disorders.
- Assist student-athletes in the normal usage of computers and typewriters.
- Direct student-athletes to on-campus services concerning career counseling.
- Direct student-athletes to Director of Athletics concerning their future professional athletics career. (See Bylaw 12.3.4 page 76 for specifics).
- Direct student-athletes to their coach regarding all other issues, concerns or questions.
