ð 2-Year Transfer**ð Qualifier:**

- must have attended at least 2 semesters or 3 quarters at 2-year college (*excluding summer*)
- must have presented a minimum of 24 semester hours (or 36 quarter hours) of transferable degree credit with a minimum of a 2.0 cumulative GPA or earned AA degree
- must have satisfactorily completed an average of at least 12 semester hours of transferable degree credit for each academic term of attendance
- or must have graduated from the two-year college with a minimum of 48 semester (or 72 quarter hours) of transferable credit with a minimum of a 2.0 cumulative GPA

ð Nonqualifier/Partial Qualifier:

- must have graduated from the 2-year college (attended at least 3 sems/4 qtrs excluding summer)
- must have satisfactorily completed a minimum of 48 hours of transferable degree credits with a minimum of a 2.0 GPA (max. summer = 18 sem. cr., no more than 9 sem. cr. the summer prior to UCONN enrollment)
- *in football and basketball* a student-athlete can only utilize this exception if he/she has satisfactorily completed 35% of requirements toward his/her UCONN degree (8/1/96)
- or see non-sponsored sport exception

ð 4-2-4 Transfer

must have left previous school in good academic standing and not competed at the two-year college in the same sport during the same academic year

ð Option 1

- must have graduated from the 2-year college (25% of credits must have been earned at the degree-granting institution)
- must have completed a minimum of 24 semester (or 36 quarter hours) hours of transferable degree credit with a minimum of a 2.0 GPA at the 2-year college
- one calendar year must have elapsed since transfer from the 4-year college

ð Option 2

- returns to the 4-year college from which he/she transferred to the 2-year college provided he/she did not have an unfulfilled residence requirement at the time of the transfer from the 4-year college

ð Option 3

- must have initially enrolled in a 4-year college that never sponsored the sport on the intercollegiate level
- must be a qualifier presenting a minimum of 24 semester hours (or 46 quarter hours) transferable degree credits with a minimum of a 2.0 cumulative GPA
- must have satisfactorily completed an average of at least 12 semester or quarter hours of transferable degree credits during each academic term of attendance
- must have spent at least 2 semesters / 3 quarters in residence at the 2-year college
- or see non-sponsored sport exception
