PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Alisha Glass, Penn State
FR, S, Leland, Mich./Leland

Glass was the driving force behind Penn State's two impressive wins over ranked Big 12 teams this past weekend in Austin, Texas. Against No. 15 Missouri, Glass dished out a career-high 44 assists while adding three kills, seven digs and five blocks. In addition, she directed the Nittany Lions to a team hitting percentage of .339 with three different players reaching double-digit kill numbers. The following night versus the seventh-ranked Longhorns, Glass again set a new career high with 63 assists and recorded eight kills on a career-high-tying .438 hitting with a career-best-tying seven blocks and 16 digs, one shy of her personal best. She led the team to an astounding .320 hitting percentage in the five-game match while four players reached double-digit kills and all six attackers hit higher than .263 in the contest. For the weekend, Glass averaged 13.38 assists per game, 2.88 digs per game and 1.50 blocks per game while directing the squad to a team hitting percentage of .327 with an average of 17.38 kills per game against two teams in the Top 15 in the nation.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Kerry Hance, Michigan

Hance led the Wolverines in digs in each of their matches, backstopping Michigan with 5.44 digs per game in the tournament. The Michigan sophomore had 10 digs in game one against Pacific and nine in game three versus Virginia to spark Michigan in key frames. This is the first time Hance has led the Wolverines in digs for three-straight matches since assuming full-time libero duties to start the season. With her work this weekend, Hance improved her digs per game to 4.53, passing last year's libero and current setter Stesha Selsky for the team lead.

2006 PRESEASON HONORS

THREE-TIME DEFENDING BIG TEN CHAMPION PENN STATE TABBED PRESEASON FAVORITE BY CONFERENCE COACHES

Three-time defending Big Ten champion Penn State has been voted for the second-consecutive season by the conference coaches as the preseason favorite for the upcoming season. Wisconsin, last year's Big Ten runner-up, was tabbed second, followed by Minnesota at the No. 3 position. The conference coaches also selected a 12-member Preseason All-Big Ten team, which is led in representation by the Nittany Lions, Golden Gophers and Ohio State with three selections each.

Michigan, which leaped into the nation's top 25 this week at No. 22, is a perfect 10-0 and off to its best start in program history.

Perfect Purdue to Hit the West Coast

At 9-0, No. 14 Purdue takes off this week for the West Coast, where it will travel to No. 9 Southern California on Friday and then to No. 20 Pepperdine on Saturday. Last season, the Boilermakers were victorious in their first 11 matches.

Big Ten Leads Country in Three Stat Categories

Michigan State is the nation's top team in two statistical categories, while Penn State leads the country and a host of Big Ten squads in another. As of Sept. 4, the Spartans were tops in assists (17.47) and kills per game (18.74). Penn State's 4.23 blocks per game is the best mark in the nation, but five conference teams follow closely behind in the top 30. Wisconsin (3.50) is 11th, Michigan (3.28) is 22nd, while Northwestern (3.27) and Minnesota (3.27) are tied for 23rd overall and Michigan State (3.08) is 28th.

Five Schools Ranked in Nation's Top 25

Five Big Ten volleyball teams are ranked in the CSTV/AVCA Top 25 Coaches Poll. Penn State, which garnered 12 first-place votes, leads the Big Ten contingent at No. 2, followed by No. 11 Wisconsin, No. 14 Purdue and No. 15 Ohio State. Michigan entered the poll this week at No. 22, while Minnesota continues to receive votes.

Odds and Ends

During last week's play, Illinois' Beth Vrdsky became the seventh Illinois player to have ever reached the 1,000-dig mark, while her teammate Lizzie Bazzetta set a career high with 63 assists against Wichita State, only to follow it up with 62 in a four-game win over the College of Charleston • Michigan State (7-1) is off to its best start since 2001 • Last weekend at Hawaii, Northwestern freshman Kate Nobilio set the Wildcat single-match digs record for a four-game contest with 34 in a loss to the Rainbow Wahine, which NU lost by only seven combined points • Wisconsin's Jocelyn Wack extended her NCAA record for matches with double-figure digs to 71 last week.

Illini Standout Stars in Big Ten Campaign

Beth Vrdsky, a senior specialist on the Illinois squad, is one of 11 selected student-athletes that will be the face of the Big Ten Conference this year as it celebrates its 25th Anniversary of Women's Championships. Vrdsky has been featured in a 30-second public service announcement "sharing her story" about her dreams of becoming a fighter pilot.
