BIG 12 NOTEBOOK

- The Big 12 led all conferences with four teams ranked in the Top 10 in the final AP and Coaches polls, twice as many as any other league with multiple teams. It marks the second time in league history (2001) the Conference finished the season with four teams ranked in the Top 10.
- Big 12 teams posted a 5-3 mark in bowl games, tying the Conference's all-time best record (2005, 02).
- An all-time high eight Big 12 players earned Consensus All-America recognition this season.
- The Big 12 finished the season with seven teams listed in the Top 20 nationally in total offense.
- Michael Crabtree (Texas Tech) and Jordy Nelson (Kansas State) finished the season ranked No. 1 and 2, respectively, in the NCAA for receptions and receiving yards per game. Crabtree also established an NCAA freshman record with 22 touchdown catches.
- Sam Bradford (Oklahoma) led the NCAA in pass efficiency (176.5).
- Graham Harrell (Texas Tech) averaged a nation's best 431.8 yards of offense.
- Dantrell Savage (Oklahoma State) led the Big 12 with ten 100-yard rushing games this season.
- Tony Temple (Missouri) rushed for a Cotton Bowl record 281 yards, the second highest all-time single-game bowl rushing total.
- Dallas Griffin (Texas) won the 2007 Draddy Award, the "academic Heisman" presented annually by the National Football Foundation.
- Eleven Big 12 teams have played in bowl games since 2005.
- Ten Big 12 teams return their starting quarterback next season.

All-America

Ten Big 12 players - Anthony Collins, Kansas; Michael Crabtree, Texas Tech; Jordon Dizon, Colorado; Tony Hills, Texas; Curtis Lofton, Oklahoma; Jeremy Maclin, Missouri; Jordy Nelson, Kansas State; Martin Rucker, Missouri; Duke Robinson, Oklahoma; Aqib Talib, Kansas - garnered first team All-America honors in 2007 from at least one of the five organizations used in the consensus chart (American Football Coaches Association, Associated Press, Football Writers Association of America, The Sporting News, and Walter Camp Foundation).

Consensus

An all-time high eight Big 12 players earned Consensus All-America recognition - Michael Crabtree, Texas Tech; Jordon Dizon, Colorado; Curtis Lofton, Oklahoma; Jeremy Maclin, Missouri; Jordy Nelson, Kansas State; Martin Rucker, Missouri; Duke Robinson, Oklahoma and Aqib Talib, Kansas. The previous high-water mark was 2003 when six Conference players gained Consensus All-America.

Attendance

For the second consecutive year total attendance in the Big 12 surpassed 4.6 million fans. This season, 4,652,267 people attended league stadiums. In the past two years an all-time high 9,333,306 have passed through the turnstiles of Big 12 stadiums, the highest two-year mark in league history.

Stadiums in the Big 12 were filled to 96.6 percent of capacity this season, the ninth straight year over 90 percent.

Average attendance in 2007 was 60,419, the highest in league history and first time to average over 60,000.

Eye Popping

The prime-time telecast of the Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship game registered a 6.8 rating, topping the Missouri/Kansas (6.59) game one-week prior as the highest rated regular-season ABC/ESPN telecast in 2007, giving the Big 12 the two highest rated games on the ABC/ESPN platforms this season.

Big 12 BCS Success

From 2000-05 teams from the Big 12 played in the BCS National Championship Game five times during the six-year span. Since the inception of the BCS, the Big 12 is 2-3 in the National Championship Game. Texas (2005) and Oklahoma (2000) have won titles, while Nebraska (2001) and Oklahoma (2003, '04) were denied crowns.

National Title Appearances

The Big 12 leads all conferences with five appearances in the BCS National Championship Game.

BCS Sightings

The 2007 campaign marked the fourth time the Big 12 advanced two teams to BCS games in the same season (2001, 03, 04). Including the 2007 season, Big 12 teams have played in 14 BCS games in the 10-year history of the structure, posting a 6-8 mark.

Final Rankings

The Big 12 led all conferences with four teams ranked in the Top 10 of the final Associated Press and Coaches polls with Missouri (4/5), Kansas (7/7), Oklahoma (8/8) and Texas (10/10). Texas Tech (22/23) also ended the season in the rankings. 2001 was the only other season in conference history in which the Big 12 finished with four teams in the Top 10.

Scoring

Four Big 12 teams rank in the Top 8 in the country in scoring offense (Kansas-2, Oklahoma-5, Texas Tech-7, Missouri-8), and six in the Top 20 (Texas-14, Kansas State-18).

Getting Offensive

The Big 12 leads all conferences with seven teams ranked in the NCAA Top 20 for total offense (Texas Tech-2, Missouri-5, Oklahoma State-7, Kansas-8, Nebraska-9, Texas-13, Oklahoma-19).

Individually Speaking

The Big 12 is home to three of the nation's Top 5 receptions per game leaders (Michael Crabtree-Texas Tech, Jordy Nelson-Kansas State, Danny Amendola-Texas Tech), the Top 2 in receiving yards (Michael Crabtree-Texas Tech, Jordy Nelson-Kansas State), and two of the Top 7 in total offense (Graham Harrell-Texas Tech, Chase Daniel-Missouri).

Football Media Day

Kansas City is the scheduled site for the 2008 edition of Big 12 Football Media Day. This year's event will be held July 21-23, at a site to be determined.

13th Annual Dr Pepper Big 12 Football Championship

For the fifth time in league history the Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship game will be held in Kansas City at Arrowhead Stadium. The 2008 game takes place on Saturday, December 6. Previous Big 12 Championship games staged at Arrowhead were in 2000, 03, 04 and 06.

Big 12 Media Preseason Poll

Media covering the conference have correctly predicted the division champions in four of the last six seasons (OU/NU-06; UT/CU-05; OU/KSU-03, CU/OU-02). Overall, including the 2007 season, the top spot in each division has been accurately picked by the league's media corps 14-of-24 times. Bowling

The 2007 season marked the sixth time in the last seven seasons the Big 12 has sent eight teams to bowl games. However with two teams in the BCS, the Big 12 did not fill the Texas Bowl, its eighth and final slot.

Bowl Attendance

For the second time in league history over half-a-million fans attended bowl games involving Big 12 teams. This season, 503,605 people attended the eight post-season games with Big 12 teams, just shy of the Conference's high water mark of 505,769 set following the 2001 regular season.

Welcome

The Big 12 welcomes three new head coaches to the league in 2008 with the additions of Art Briles (Baylor), Bo Pelini (Nebraska) and Mike Sherman (Texas A&M).

(3-9, 0-8)

Art Briles has been named the 25th head football coach in BU history. Briles was 34-28 in five seasons as head coach at Houston.

Five Baylor players recorded at least 30 receptions each in 2007 for the first time in school history. The five 30-catch receivers were Justin Akers, David Gettis, Brad Taylor, Brandon Whitaker and Thomas White.

FS Jordan Lake recorded six double-digit tackle games in 2007. He had 120 tackles, the most by a Baylor player since Maurice Lane had 129 in 2003.

QB Blake Szymanski established a Baylor single-season record for touchdowns with 23 (22 passing, 1 rushing).



COLORADO
(6-7, 4-4)

CU has scored in 235 straight games, the fourth-longest active streak in the NCAA and the ninth-longest all-time. The Buffs have scored in 150 consecutive league games.

LB Jordon Dizon finished second in the nation and first in the Big 12 in tackles with 12.46 a game.

Senior TB Hugh Charles finished sixth all-time at CU in combined regular season and bowl game rushing yards with 2,795.

Cody Hawkins set freshman school records in passing yards (2,693), completions (239), attempts (424) and touchdown passes (19). He had nine 200-yard passing games, tying the school record with six in a row at one point.



IOWA STATE
(3-9, 2-6)

QB Bret Meyer ends his career ranked fourth all-time on the Big 12 career charts in total offense (10,422), third in total plays (1,923) and third in passing yards (9,499).

Wide receiver Todd Blythe finishes his career with three of the 10 top single season receiving yard totals in school history. Blythe's 31 career TD catches ties for third in Big 12 history. Blythe completed his career with 176 catches for 3,096 yards, both school records.

Bret Culbertson closed his career 100-for-100 in PATs and became the second player in ISU history with 100 career PATs. Culbertson's 214 career points ties for fifth all-time at Iowa State.

R.J. Sumrall moved into ninth place on the Iowa State career chart with 99 receptions.



KANSAS
(12-1, 7-1)

Kansas has won 15 of its last 17 games, four of its last five bowl games, and has 12 victories in a season for the first time in school history.

Aqib Talib has 13 career interceptions and returned two for touchdowns during the 2007 season. His 13 picks are tied for third among Big 12 career leaders.

Todd Reesing is the all-time school leader in touchdown passes with 36 through his sophomore campaign. His 3,486 passing yards in 2007 set a KU single-season record.

The Jayhawks finished second nationally in scoring offense (42.8) and fourth in scoring defense (16.4). KU was eighth in total offense (479.8).



KANSAS STATE
(5-7, 3-5)

Jordy Nelson was second nationally in receptions (10.2) and receiving yards (133.8) per game, trailing Michael Crabtree of Texas Tech.

Nelson concluded his K-State career second in career receptions (206), second in career receiving yards (2,822) and third in touchdown receptions (20).

Josh Freeman finished his sophomore campaign with a K-State single-season record 3,353 yards of total offense. Freeman's 5,133 career passing yards is fourth in school history. He is one of just five KSU quarterbacks to top the 5,000-yard passing mark in a career.

James Johnson rushed for 1,106 yards in 2007, the first Wildcat to run for 1,000 yards since 2004.

K-State has scored in 140 consecutive games.



MISSOURI
(12-2, 7-1)

Tony Temple rushed for a Cotton Bowl-record 281 yards and four touchdowns in Mizzou's win over Arkansas. Temple became the first Mizzou running back with back-to-back 1,000-yard seasons with 1,039 yards in 2007.

Missouri claimed a share of its first Big 12 North division title and made its first appearance in the Dr Pepper Big 12 Championship in 2007.

Chase Daniel set school records for total offense (4,559 yards), passing yards (4,306) and touchdown passes (33) in a season.

Daniel finished second in the Big 12 and seventh nationally, averaging 325.6 yards of total offense.

Mizzou was fifth nationally in total offense (490.3 ypg), ninth in passing offense (314.1 ypg) and eighth in scoring offense (39.9 ppg).



NEBRASKA
(5-7, 2-6)

Bo Pelini was named NU's 28th head football coach. He previously served as the Huskers' defensive coordinator in 2003 before stops at Oklahoma and LSU.

In his three career starts, QB Joe Ganz produced three of the top five single-game passing efforts in school history and three of the four 400-yard passing games in school annals.

WR Maurice Purify had four 100-yard receiving games in 2007, tying the NU season record (Johnny Rodgers in 1971 and 1972).

Junior I-back Marlon Lucky became the first player in Nebraska history to surpass 1,000 career rushing (1,876) and receiving (1,091) yards.



OKLAHOMA
(11-3, 6-2)

Oklahoma won its fifth league title in six appearances in 2007, both Big 12 records. The Sooners are also the first team to win consecutive Big 12 titles.

The Sooners finished the 2007 season with a school-record 80 touchdowns.

Sam Bradford established an NCAA freshman record for touchdown passes with 36. Bradford finished first nationally in passing efficiency at 176.5.

Oklahoma leads the nation with its 30th 10-win season. Alabama is second with 28.



OKLAHOMA STATE
(7-6, 4-4)

Oklahoma State's bowl winning percentage of .667 ranks third on the NCAA's all-time list and best in the Big 12.

Dantrell Savage ended his career with his 10th consecutive 100-yard rushing game, the third-longest streak in Cowboy history. Savage became the 15th player in OSU history to surpass 2,000 yards rushing in his career and finished with 2,092.

Zac Robinson finished the 2007 season with a school-record 3,671 yards of total offense. He ranks ninth on OSU's career total offense list with 4,160 yards.

Adarius Bowman finished the season with 1,006 yards receiving, making him just the second receiver in OSU history to eclipse 1,000 yards in multiple seasons.



TEXAS
(10-3, 5-3)

The Longhorns played in a bowl game for a UT-record 10th straight season. UT has won six of its last seven bowl games, including four straight, and has a 7-3 record in bowl contests under Mack Brown.

Jamaal Charles moved into fourth place on UT's all-time rushing list with 3,328 yards, passing Chris Gilbert (3,231, 1966-68). Charles had seven 100-yard rushing games in 2007 and 11 in his career.

Colt McCoy is the fourth QB in Texas history to throw for 3,000 yards in a season (3,303). He stands in second place on UT's single-season passing list after moving past Vince Young and Chris Simms in 2007.

Quan Cosby has recorded a reception in 31 consecutive games.

UT produced over 400 yards of offense nine times in 2007.



TEXAS A&M
(7-6, 4-4)

Mike Sherman was named head football coach at Texas A&M after serving on the staff of the Houston Texans since 2006. In his previous two stints at Texas A&M (1989-93, 1995-96) he was a part of three conference championships.

Texas A&M ended the 2007 season second in the Big 12 and 13th nationally in rushing yards with 211.6 a game.

Junior Martellus Bennett set the school record for career receiving yards by an Aggie tight end. He had 1,246 yards on 105 career catches. The 105 career catches tie for the TE school record. Bennett is the seventh Aggie in school history to surpass the 100-catch plateau.

Senior Kerry Franks broke the school record for season kickoff return yardage with 644 yards on 25 returns.



TEXAS TECH
(9-4, 4-4)

Texas Tech's victory over Virginia in the Gator Bowl is its 10th bowl win in school history and fifth in the last six years.

Alex Trlica holds the NCAA career record for extra points made with 231. He also holds the NCAA mark for career extra points without a miss, as he made every attempt during his career. His 377 career points rank second on Tech's career scoring list.

Redshirt freshman Michael Crabtree led the country in receptions (10.3) and receiving yards (150.9), and was seventh in scoring (10.15 ppg).

Graham Harrell became the second quarterback in Tech history to throw for 5,000-plus yards in a single season, ending the year with 5,705. Only six quarterbacks in NCAA history have reached the 5,000-yard mark in a single season.
