TEXAS BEATS OKLAHOMA STATE IN BIG 12 CHAMPIONSHIP SEMIFINAL

SAN ANTONIO -- Junior Kelsey Carpenter scored her 13th goal of the year and eighth game-winning goal to lead No. 3 seed Texas to a 2-0 win over No. 2 Oklahoma State in the Big 12 Soccer Championship at Blossom Soccer Stadium.

Carpenter has scored back-to-back game-winning goals for the second time this season after also providing the decisive score in Wednesday's quarterfinal victory over Nebraska. Her eight game-winners are a school record.

The Longhorns advance to their third championship game, all since 2001, and will face No. 5 seed Colorado at 1:00 p.m. (CST) Sunday. UT improves its record to 17-3-1 while OSU falls to 16-3-2.

Texas extended its winning streak to eight straight and its unbeaten streak to nine consecutive matches. The Horns' last loss was to Oklahoma State, 1-0, on Sept. 29. OSU saw its nine-match unbeaten streak come to an end. The Cowgirls' last loss prior to tonight was on Sept. 27 at Texas A&M. UT and OSU tied for second in the Big 12 regular season with 8-1-1 records.

Carpenter put the Longhorns on the board five minutes before the half when she headed in the ball from inside the six-yard box. Priscilla Fite and Amy Burlingham assisted on the play. Freshman Emily Anderson came in off the bench to add an insurance goal in the second half.

The championship match will be telecast on a tape-delayed basis by FSN. Check local listings for telecast times in your area.
