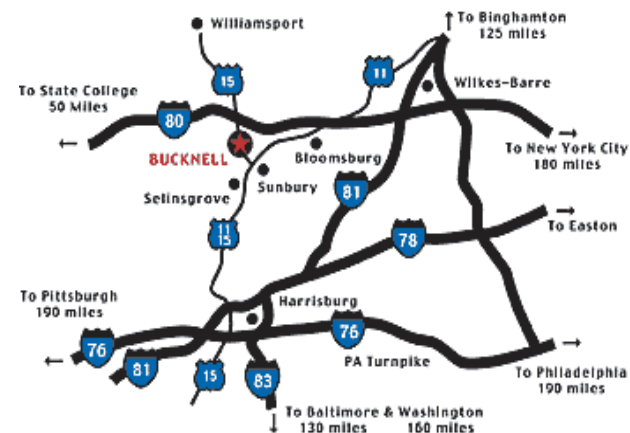


### What to Bring:
