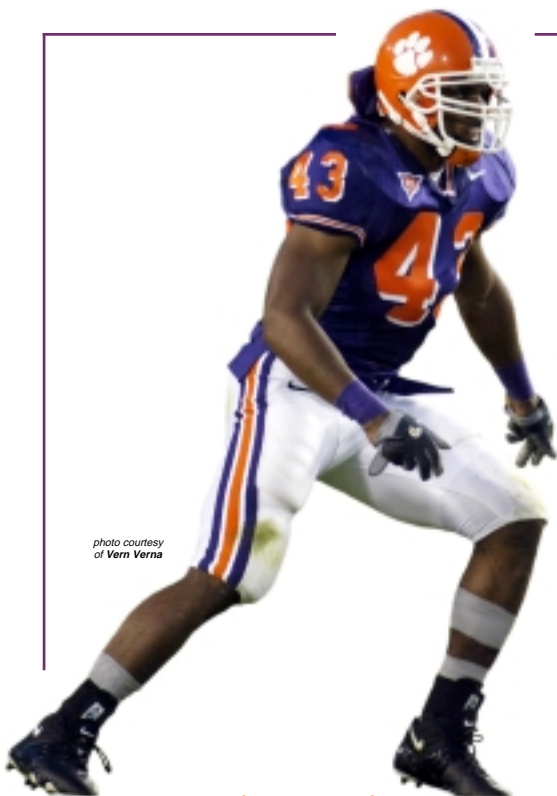
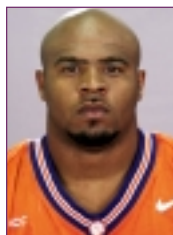

Tackles for Loss &
Solo Tackles

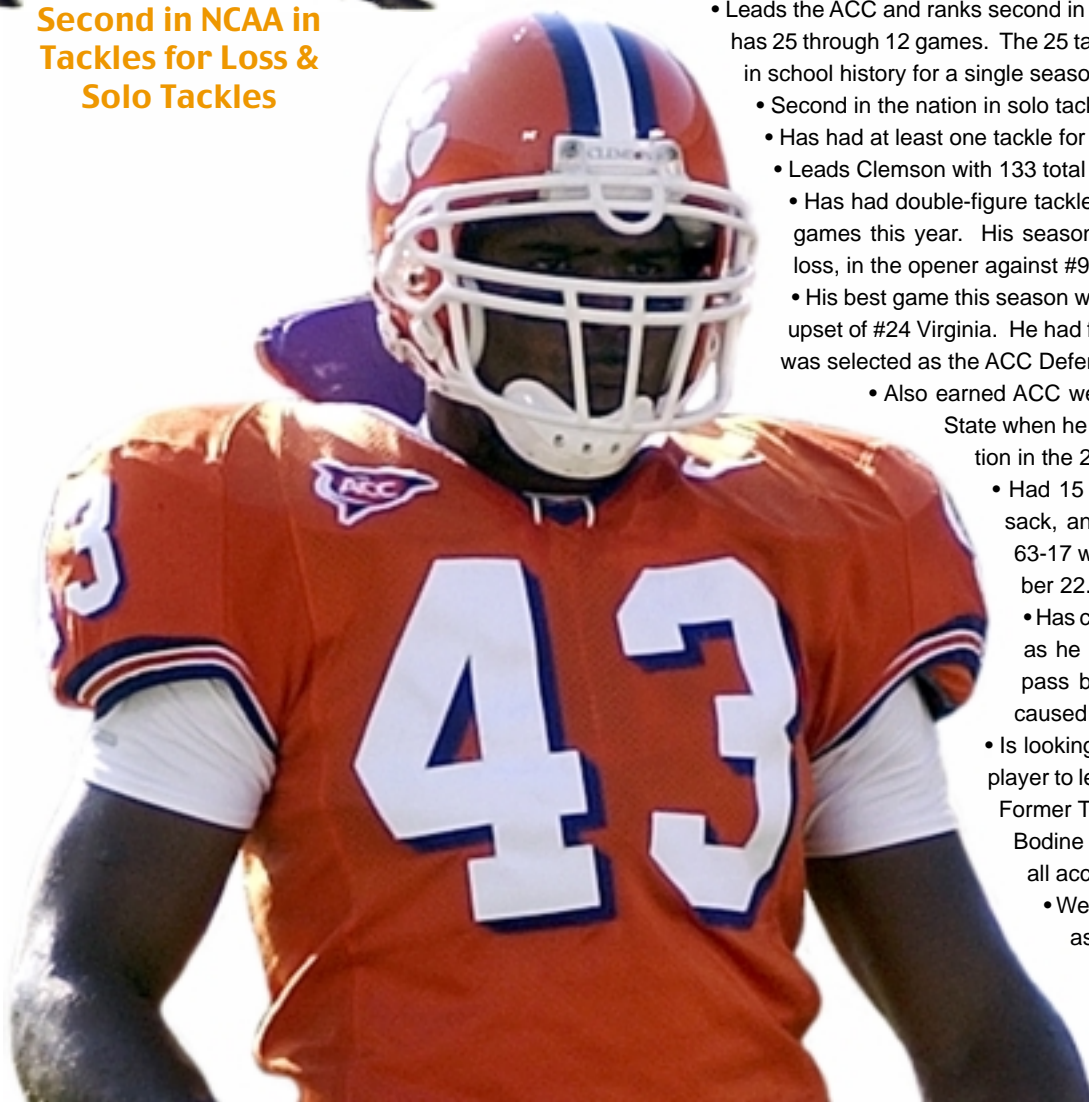

- First-Team All-ACC linebacker.
- Leads the ACC and ranks second in the nation in tackles for loss; he has 25 through 12 games. The 25 tackles for loss rank tied for fourth in school history for a single season.
 - Second in the nation in solo tackles (101).
 - Has had at least one tackle for loss in 10 of the 12 games.
 - Leads Clemson with 133 total tackles, including 101 solo.
 - Has had double-figure tackle efforts in nine of Clemson's 12 games this year. His season high is 16, including three for loss, in the opener against #9 Georgia.
 - His best game this season was the October 11 Homecoming upset of #24 Virginia. He had four tackles for loss, a sack, and was selected as the ACC Defensive Lineman-of-the-Week.
 - Also earned ACC weekly honors against #3 Florida State when he had 10 tackles and an interception in the 26-10 win.
 - Had 15 tackles, four tackles for loss, a sack, and an interception in Clemson's 63-17 win at South Carolina on November 22.
 - Has contributed in all areas of defense, as he has a team-high six sacks, two pass breakups, three interceptions, a caused fumble, and recovered fumble.
 - Is looking to become the fourth Clemson player to lead the nation in tackles for loss. Former Tigers William Perry (1984), Rob Bodine (1991), and Keith Adams (1999) all accomplished the feat.
 - Wears the same jersey number (43) as former Tiger defensive greats Terry Kinard and Keith Adams.
 - Perhaps the most improved linebacker in the nation; he had just 29 tackles all of last season as a reserve.
