RENEWALS & NEW ORDERS NOW BEING TAKEN

RENEWALS

Renewal applications for current season ticket holders are now available online. If we don't receive your renewal before April 28, 2006, an order form will be mailed to current season ticket holders at their physical address. Additional seat requests should be made at time of initial order. Additional seat requests may require a Patriot Club donation based on your current level of giving and seat request location. Current season ticket holders are encouraged to support George Mason University Athletics with a donation to the Patriot Club but a donation is not required at this time. Order forms must be returned to the Athletic Ticket Office by August 1, 2006. Season ticket holders requesting additional seats must return their order form by July 1, 2006. The renewal deadline is one month earlier than in the past due to the heavy volume of requests for new orders we are already receiving. Renewals received after this date will be considered late. Late orders are subject to seat relocation.

MINI SEASON TICKET UPGRADES

Current 3-game or 6-game mini plan season ticket holders can upgrade to a full season plan via the online application beginning immediately. In order to receive priority over new season ticket holders, applications must be returned to the Athletic Ticket Office by July 1, 2006. Renewals received after this date will be placed at the new order priority level. A donation to the Patriot Club will be required for preferred seating locations (see below). Mini season ticket packages will be on sale beginning September 1, 2006 and will most likely be assigned at a higher location than in the past based on new season ticket orders.

NEW ORDERS

Applications for new season ticket holders are available now. A donation to the Patriot Club will be required for preferred seating locations.

PAYMENT

Season ticket holders are encouraged to renew their season tickets via the online form at GoMason.com. It's quick and easy – simply complete the form and fax or mail to us. Complete instructions are online. A new method of renewal is the EZ-Pay option in which your seats are automatically renewed each season. EZ-Pay is a convenient option for loyal Patriot fans. Your credit card will be charged annually until you decide to change or cancel.

We accept the following forms of payment: personal check (made payable to GMU), Visa, and MasterCard. For credit card renewals please include your credit card number, expiration date and signature. If you would like your card to be charged in four monthly installments please check the appropriate box. Please do not renew season tickets by phone.

SEASON TICKET PRICES

The price of a season ticket is as follows:

- *Adult* \$130
- *My 1st Season ticket* \$85: Full season ticket plan at a special price for youth (18 & under)
- *Faculty/Staff* \$110
- *Family Plan* \$260: Full season plan in a special section for families (sect 114), includes two adult tickets and two youth tickets.
- *VIP floor seats* \$300: Patriot Club Diamond Patriot membership level required.
- *Mason Young Alumni* \$65: 3-years or less removed from graduation.

PATRIOT CLUB PREFERRED SEATING

New season ticket holders or season ticket holders looking to add seats who wish to be in preferred seating areas are required to make the appropriate annual per seat donation to the Patriot Club by July 31, 2006 to receive a preferred seat location. The Patriot Club donation is in addition to the cost of the season tickets. Minimum required donations are as follows:

- *VIP Floor seats*: \$5,000 donation for four seats
- *Sec. 130, 101, 102, 115, 116, & 117 first six rows*: \$3,000 donation for four seats
- *Sec. 130, 101, 102, 115, 116, & 117 rows A-F (7 – 12 rows up from the floor)*: \$400 donation per seat
- *Sec. 129, 103, 118 below the concourse (rows F & below), 101 & 116 above the concourse (rows G – M)*: \$50 donation per seat
- *Sec. 129, 103, 118 (rows G – M)*: \$25 donation per seat

INFORMATION FOR DONORS TO ATHLETICS WHO HAVE NOT PURCHASED SEASON TICKETS TO DATE

Donors to athletics at the Patriot level and higher (for 2005) will receive a mailing to purchase season tickets this May. If you would like to purchase season tickets, complete the order form and return it in the envelope provided. Demand is expected to be extremely high and we want to give you first priority for your loyal support. Please return your order form by August 1 and your priority will be based on current standing in the priority point system. All requests for new or additional season tickets will be processed in priority point order. In order to be considered for available seats in the preferred areas, contributions to the Patriot Club must be received by July 31, 2006 and must meet or exceed the annual seating contribution for the sections requested. Many of the prime seat locations require gifts in excess of the minimum to have enough priority points to qualify. Processing of payment does not constitute final acceptance of order. If additional seats become available to current patrons with season tickets they will not, in all probability, be adjacent to current season ticket locations.

SEAT CHANGES

The Athletic Ticket Office reserves the right to change any seat assignment without prior notice. Conditions that cause changes are: (1) orders received after the Aug. 1 deadline, (2) failure to maintain the required preferred seating contribution by the specified deadline for new orders only, and (3) extenuating circumstances.

PRIORITY POINT SYSTEM

The Athletic Department will use the Priority Point System to prioritize all ticket and parking requests for Patriot Athletics. Donors who contribute a minimum of \$50 to Patriot Athletics in 2006 will receive Priority Points. Priority points are based on current annual unrestricted donation to the Patriot Club, cumulative donations to the Patriot Club, consecutive years of donating to the Patriot Club, and consecutive years of purchasing full season basketball tickets. SEAT IMPROVEMENT REQUESTS

Attrition is expected to be extremely low this season; therefore opportunities for seat improvement will be limited. Keep the following points in mind if you wish to request improvement.

- Improvements are based on attrition or availability and awarded by priority points. The number of years requesting improvement has no bearing and requests are not carried over from previous years.
- A seat change request should be put in writing and attached to your season ticket renewal application or be written on the form itself. Please detail your request as much as possible.
- In order to be considered for any available seats in preferred areas, your contribution to the Patriot Club must have been received by July 31, 2006 and must meet or exceed the annual seating contribution for the sections you requested.
- If you are part of a group, state whether you are willing to split from the group in order to improve your seating. The more seats involved, the harder it becomes to improve your seat location.
- Each request is reviewed, but the volume of requests does not make personal consultation feasible. Decisions are based on the best judgment of the Athletic Ticket Office.

ADDITIONAL SEATS

Current Patriot Club donors and season ticket holders will be given priority over new season ticket holders. Those that would like to request additional season tickets should write the request on the renewal form or attach a separate letter. **DO NOT** include payment for the seats requested. In the event seats become available the Athletic Ticket Office will invoice patrons and ask for payment at that time. Please be aware that attrition is expected to be extremely low this season; therefore, only a limited number of seats may become available to donors and current season ticket holders. In order to be considered for available seats in the preferred seating areas, contributions to the Patriot Club must be received by July 31, 2006 and must meet or exceed the annual seating contribution for the sections requested. Many of the prime seat locations require gifts in excess of the minimum to have enough priority points to qualify. All requests for new or additional season tickets will be processed in priority point order. Seats that become available most likely **WILL NOT** be adjacent to current season ticket locations. Processing of payment does not constitute final acceptance of order.

PATRIOT CLUB BENEFITS

Gifts made to the Patriot Club provide scholarship funds for Mason student-athletes. Gifts of all levels are important to the success of Mason Athletics. Benefits are provided at each giving level. Check GoMason.com or call 703 993-3215 for more details.

PATRIOT CLUB HOSPITALITY ROOMS

For Patriot Club donors at the Bronze Patriot and Silver Patriot levels, pre-game, half time, and post-game hospitality is available in the Green and Gold room located on the concourse. One pass is provided to donors who make an unrestricted scholarship donation of at least \$400. Additional passes may be purchased from the Patriot Club for \$400. There may be a limit of the number of additional passes to be made available for purchase.

For Patriot Club donors at the Gold Patriot levels and higher (\$3,000), pre-game, half-time, and post-game hospitality is available in the Patriot Room, which is located on the floor level. Four passes are provided to donors who make an unrestricted scholarship donation of at least \$3,000. Eight passes are provided for donors who make a contribution at the Diamond Level or above (\$5,000). Additional passes may be purchased to those that qualify for \$750. There may be a limit to the number of additional passes to be made available for purchase.

PARKING

Patriot Club donors at the Silver Patriot (\$1,000) will receive one complimentary priority parking permit. This permit allows access into specific lots, as space is available. Due to the nature of playing on campus, specific games during times when classes are in session could result in only a limited number of parking spaces being available prior to game time.

Patriot Club donors at the Gold Patriot level (\$3,000) and higher will receive two complimentary reserved parking permits. This permit allows access into specific lots and rows, as space is available. Due to the nature of playing on campus, specific games during times when classes are still in session could result in only a limited number of parking spaces being available prior to game time.

POST SEASON TICKET PRIORITY

Priority for all post-season tickets will be given to Patriot Club donors, then season ticket holders. Donors to sport-specific funds must make unrestrictive gifts to the Patriot Club's annual scholarship fund to "activate" their Patriot Club status.
