# TICKET APPLICATION

## The 2008 NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Championship The Road to the Final Four® Begins in Washington, DC March 20 & 22, 2008 at Verizon Center Hosted by Georgetown University

- Ticket order forms will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis unless demand warrants the need for a random-selection process.
  - In case of a random-selection process, applicants will be notified whether they were successful by June 1, 2007. Refunds will be issued to unsuccessful applicants.
  - Applicants will receive tickets no later than January 31, 2008. If tickets are not received by this date it is the applicant's responsibility to contact the host ticket office.
  - During the week of April 9- April 13 only, applications can be hand delivered to McDonough Arena Ticket Window at Georgetown University for no service charge, during the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.
  - Payment may be in the form of a check, money order, MasterCard, Visa, American Express, or Discover card. The same credit card may not be used for payment on multiple accounts or applications.
  - Checks will be deposited upon receipt. Credit card orders will be processed upon receipt. If an applicant's check is deposited or credit card is debited, that indicates the application has been received. **It does not mean the applicant will receive tickets.**
  - Payment by check or money order must be made by one separate check or money order for each order form.
  - Tickets will not be refunded, exchanged, or returned.
  - Unless specifically authorized by NCAA, tickets may not be offered as a prize in a sweepstakes, drawing, auction or contest.
  - Tickets are for two sessions on Thursday and one session on Saturday, for a total of three tickets.
  - The only person who will be permitted to initiate an investigation of tickets or refund checks is the person whose name appears on the original application. All inquiries must be in writing and must include a photocopy of the original application.
  - Errors made on the application are the responsibility of the applicant and cannot be changed once the application has been received
  - Applicants who require assistance for persons with disabilities should note this accommodation on the ticket form.
  - Georgetown University will not play at this site.
  - Please note seats may be allocated in the same row or adjacent rows when seating blocks are assigned
  - Every person regardless of age must have a ticket
