FLAMES DO BATTLE WITH DIRTBAGS IN LONG BEACH:

Following splits with Air Force and Creighton in a pair of two-game sets last weekend at HoHoKam Park, the spring training home of the Chicago Cubs, the UIC baseball team travels to Long Beach, Calif., to take on nationally-ranked Long Beach State in a three-game series at Blair Field. The series opener takes place this Friday at 6:30 p.m. Pacific/8:30 p.m. Central as UIC junior RHP Zach Peterson (0-0, 0.00), fresh off his seven shutout innings against Creighton, takes on LBSU RHP Jared Hughes (2-0, 3.86).

QUICK NOTES

This weekend's series marks the first meeting between UIC and Long Beach State...UIC begins the season with its first 17 games on the road...RHP Zach Peterson's seven-inning four-hitter against Creighton on Feb. 17 did not result in a decision for the starter, but it kept his streak of wins in his last nine decisions dating back to last season intact...Peterson has not lost since March 21, 2005 against Ohio State...In 11 at-bats, redshirt freshman 1B Jake Carr leads the Flames and the Horizon League in hitting with a .455 average (5-for-11)...UIC is off to a strong start at the plate with a cumulative batting average of .302, far above league rival UW-Milwaukee's second-place .244...The Flames smacked 10 doubles in four games last weekend, led by junior CF Larry Gempp Jr.'s four two-baggers...UIC went 6-for-9 in steal attempts over the weekend...Long Beach State is ranked 17th by *Collegiate Baseball* and 18th by *Baseball America*...Friday's game marks the first ranked opponent that the Flames will face this season, with No. 23/19 Mississippi on tap next week...13 players made their UIC debut last weekend.

ABOUT THE DIRTBAGS: Long Beach State enters the series with the Flames at 6-4 overall, coming off a 2-1 loss to Oklahoma at the Coca-Cola Classic in Houston, Texas after picking up wins against Lamar and then-No. 5 Rice. Known on the diamond as "the Dirtbags," Long Beach State opened the season with a three-game sweep of then-No. 17 USC. Long Beach State has earned five consecutive NCAA Regional bids and 15 overall in school history, highlighted by four College World Series appearances. Leading the charge for LBSU is 3B Evan Longoria, who is hitting .438 in 10 games with three home runs and seven RBI. Mike Weathers is in his fourth season as head coach of Long Beach State, compiling a record of 163-88 during that time.

FLAMES TABBED FOR FIRST...AGAIN:

For the third consecutive year, UIC was picked to finish first in the Horizon League Preseason Coaches Poll released on Feb. 1. The Flames were a unanimous pick atop the poll, followed by 2005 league runner-up UW-Milwaukee and Youngstown State. Wright State, Butler and Cleveland State rounded out the poll.

HALL OF FAMER:

UIC Head Coach Mike Dee was recognized for his outstanding coaching contributions, as the Wisconsin Baseball Coaches Association inducted Dee into the organization's Hall of Fame on Feb. 11. Before Dee's successful collegiate coaching career at UIC and as an assistant at Minnesota, he served as head coach of Aquinas High School in La Crosse, Wis., for six seasons. At Aquinas, Dee won four straight state titles and was named Wisconsin Coach of the Year in 1987.

PETEY IS TOUGH TO BEAT:

Junior RHP Zach Peterson ended the 2005 season unbeatable, and the third-year hurler began 2006 the same way. Peterson pitched seven shutout innings in his season debut on Feb. 17 against 2005 NCAA Regional participant Creighton, giving up only four hits and a mere walk. The Minnetonka, Minn., native capped last season by winning his last nine decisions to go 10-1 overall, with his biggest win coming against UW-Milwaukee in the 2005 Horizon League Tournament championship game. Peterson's last defeat, the only blemish on his record in 2005, came on March 21, 2005 in a 4-2 loss to Ohio State.

STARTING THE CARR:

Redshirt freshman INF Jake Carr opened his collegiate career as the starter at first base in three of UIC's first four games, and his presence paid big dividends. Carr went 5-for-11 (.455) at the plate with the game-winning RBI in the tenth inning against Creighton on Feb. 17.

RUNS, LARRY, RUNS:

Junior CF Larry Gempff Jr. is starting off 2006 where left off last season: as one of UIC's top run-producers. Gempff Jr. scored a team-high five runs in four games last weekend at the leadoff spot, driving in three more runs. He capped the weekend with a .429 average (6-for-14) and a .714 slugging percentage, marked by four doubles. In 2005 Gempff Jr. batted .362 with a team-best eight homers to go along with 40 RBI and 46 runs.

MARTIN MAKES A MARK IN HIS FIRST START:

Senior RHP Ryan Martin made a strong statement in his first start of 2006 against Air Force on Feb. 18, pitching six innings and giving up only four hits and a run to pick up the victory as UIC defeated Air Force, 14-1.

AWARDS ALREADY:

With only one week in the books, two UIC players have already received recognition for their performances in Mesa. Junior RHP Zach Peterson was selected to the College Baseball Foundation National Honor Roll this week after his seven innings of shutout baseball against Creighton on Feb. 17, while senior RF Bart Babineaux was named the first Horizon League Player of the Week of the 2006 season after hitting .400 (6-for-15) with a double, a home run and a team-leading seven RBI in four games.

NEW FACES FINDING THEIR PLACES:

The Flames received considerable contributions from a slew of newcomers during opening weekend. Redshirt freshmen Jake Carr, Brett Schaefer, and Jon Brown went a combined 9-for-19 (.474) at the plate with five runs and three RBI. JC transfer Randy Krick also looked strong in his first outing, giving up only two hits against 11 batters in three innings of relief.

WHEN IT RAINS, IT POURS:

Junior INF Nick Rainwater played well in UIC's first four games, hitting two doubles and driving in three runs while scoring twice. Rainwater also stole a team-best two bases in two attempts during the four-game set in Mesa and went errorless in four starts at the hot corner.

NOLTE QUIETLY CONTINUES TO CONTRIBUTE:

Senior C/INF Bryan Nolte finished last season on the All-Horizon League Second Team, and he opened 2006 against Air Force and Creighton with a performance to back up such recognition. Nolte went 4-for-12 (.333) at the plate with a double, two runs scored and three walks. When he wasn't getting on base, Nolte spent some quality time behind the plate by throwing out two runners in three steal attempts and going errorless in catching gems by RHPs Zach Peterson and Ryan Martin in consecutive UIC wins.

FORMER FLAMES IN THE PROS:

Two former UIC players have earned well-deserved recognition as professionals this past year. Current Detroit Tigers OF Curtis Granderson made a name for himself in his first season at the big league level, where he hit .272 in 47 games to go along with eight home runs and 20 RBI en route to the Tigers Rookie of the Year award from the Detroit Sports Broadcasters' Association. He was also named the Chicago Area Major League Player of the Year by the Pitch and Hit Club of Chicago. LHP David Haehnel was rewarded for his pitching prowess as the Baltimore Orioles' farmhand was selected to Team USA for the 2005 CONCEBE Baseball Regional Qualifying Tournament this past November.
