HURRICANE LEGENDS

ORLANDO GONZALEZ 1973-74

For two seasons, 1973-74, Orlando Gonzalez was the Hurricanes force at the plate. In 1973, Gonzalez led the team in RBI (43) and stolen bases (34). The following season he led the team in batting (.402) and a then-school-record 62 stolen bases. He assisted Coach Ron Fraser's 1974 team in not only qualifying for the College World Series, but a berth in the finals against Southern California. For his efforts at the CWS, Gonzalez was named to the All-Tournament Team. Following his final year at UM, Gonzalez was awarded the prestigious Lefty Gomez Plate, awarded to College Baseball's Most Outstanding Player. He was also an All-American by the Sporting News and the NCAA Coaches. Drafted by Cleveland, Gonzalez played professionally with Oakland and Philadelphia.
