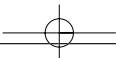

2004 NAIA MEN'S SOCCER NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP RECAP

46th Annual NAIA Men's Soccer National Championship November 17-23, 2004 - Olathe District Activity Center, Olathe, Kansas

Third seeded Lindenwood University (Mo.) won the 2004 NAIA Men's Soccer National Championship. Lindenwood defeated Auburn University Montgomery (Ala.) 1-0 at the College Boulevard Activity Center in Olathe, Kan

Lindenwood's first national championship appearance was a wet one. With a steady rain, dropping temperatures and strong winds, the Lions and Senators played to a 0-0 tie at the half. With the wind at its back, AUM threatened in the second half but was unable to finish.

Lindenwood senior defender Milivoje Cecaric scored in the the 61st minute on on a volley just over the upward reaching arms of AUM goalkeeper Bjarki Gudmundsson. Freshman midfielder Radi Zapryanof played the ball to Cecaric, who was waiting five yards out. The Lions maintained the 1-0 through the second half despite AUM having the wind advantage.

The Lindenwood defense held tournament leading scorer Hjortur Hjartarsson without a shot in the entire match. AUM managed only one shot on goal to Lindenwood's four, but total shots for each team was more even with AUM at 10 and Lindenwood at 11.

The championship match teams took home a number of honors. Lindenwood senior goalkeeper Edin Sabic was name the Outstanding Defensive Player. AUM's sophomore forward Hjortur Hjartarsson was named Outstanding Offensive Player for his six-goal tournament performance and Lindenwood sophomore forward Ignacio Novas was named Tournament Most Valuable Player.

Lindenwood finishes its season 19-3-1. Auburn Montgomery's second place finish is its third in five years. The Senators dropped to 20-5-0.
