2004 NAIA WOMEN'S SOCCER NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP RECAP

21st Annual NAIA Women's Soccer National Championship November 17-23, 2004 - Santa Barbara City College, Santa Barbara, California

A year after falling in a seven-overtime championship match, top-seeded Lindsey Wilson College (Ky.) defeated sixth-seeded Concordia University (Ore.) 2-0 in the title match of the 2004 Women's Soccer National Championship. The tournament was being hosted by Westmont College (Calif.), with games played at La Playa Stadium on the campus of Santa Barbara City College. Since the tournament went to a single elimination format in 2000, Lindsey Wilson becomes the first number-one seed to capture the national title.

After a scoreless first half, sophomore midfielder Hishamar Falconer scored her seventh goal of the season from 15 yards out off a feed from Sandra Andersson in the 65th minute. The Blue Raiders would score again for the final 2-0 margin in the 82nd minute with an unassisted 25-yard goal from sophomore forward Jill Lirbank-Almbaek.

Concordia was making their fourth consecutive national tournament appearance and advanced to the title game for the first time. They lost to Lindsey Wilson in the semifinals of last year's event by a score of 2-0. The Cavaliers allowed just 17 goals in the season, and only four in the national tournament. Concordia concludes its outstanding season with an overall record of 17-3-4.

Lindsey Wilson captures their first national championship in their sixth tournament appearance. The team finishes their season unbeaten for the first time in program history and was the number-one ranked team all season. The Blue Raiders scored two goals in the tournament and advanced by penalty kicks in their other two matches. Lindsey Wilson concludes their national championship season with an overall record of 19-0-6.
