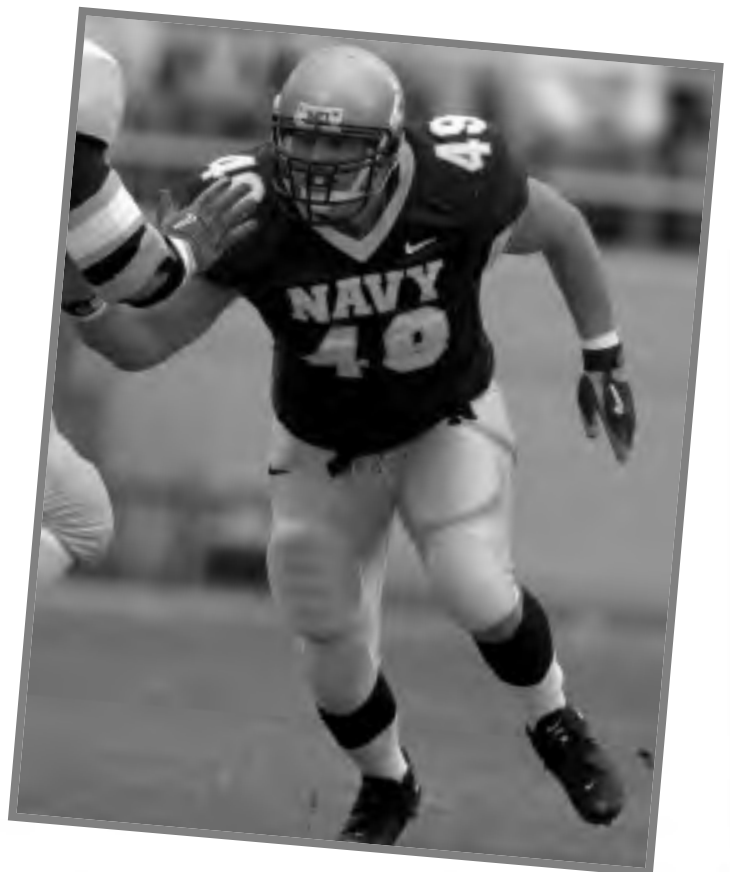

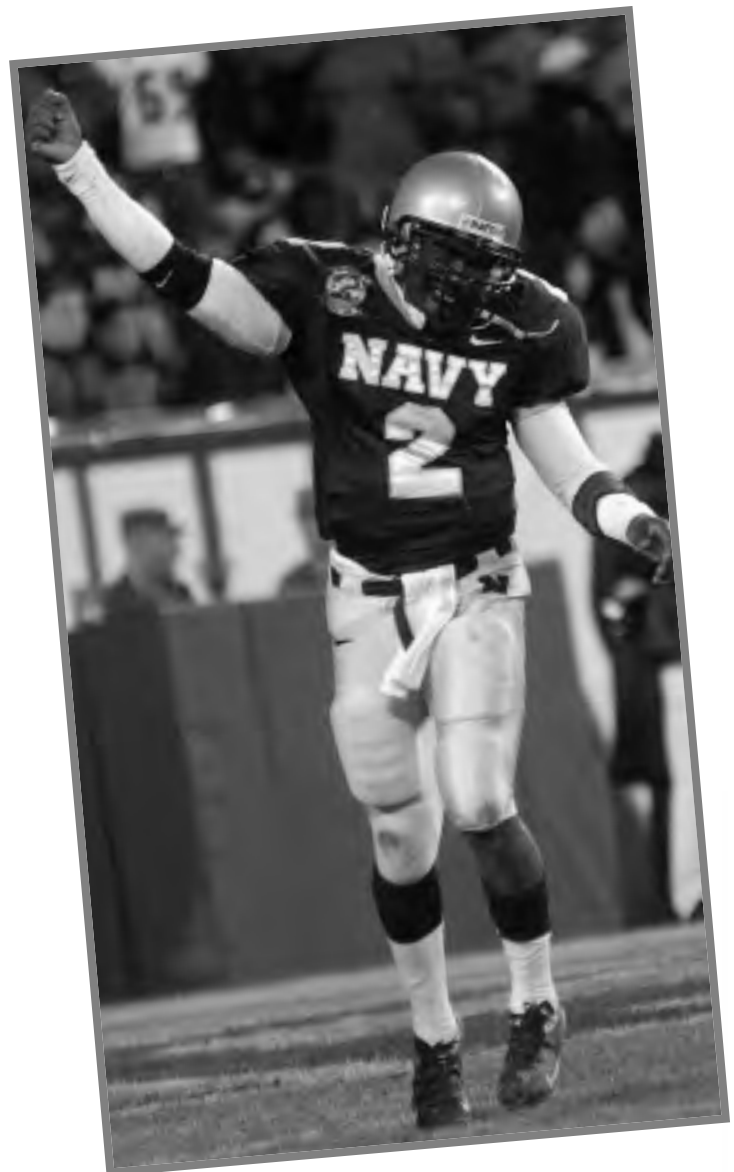

**2003:** Saw action in nine of Navy's 13 games, mostly on special teams ... recorded three tackles on the year.

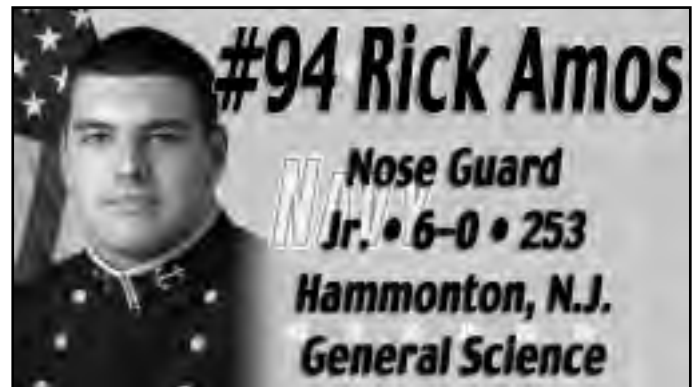
