MONOGRAM CLUB *Brennan-Boland Scholarship Fund*

An important goal of the Monogram Club is to provide financial assistance to qualified undergraduate students who are children of dues paying Monogram Club members through annual grants from the *Brennan-Boland Scholarship Fund (BBSF)*.

In order to qualify for the BBSE, students must complete the University Financial Aid Process. Potential recipients can initiate this process through contact with the Financial Aid Office at 574-631-6436. Be sure to identify yourself as a Monogram Club member. The level of financial assistance is based on demonstrated financial need.

The Monogram Club's BBSF has grown on a yearly basis from three sources: contributions from members, a portion of the annual dues and earnings from investments. The BBSF has become one of the more significant endowed scholarship funds that the University administers. For the most recent fiscal year a total of \$379,450 was awarded to children of active Monogram Club members.

The BBSF committee monitors the financial condition and expendable resources of the fund and it reviews the annual awards to qualified student recipients. Likewise, it evaluates historic, current and forecasted demographic and financial data relevant to establishing the dollar amount of financial assistance that the fund provides. The committee also maintains communication with appropriate university offices and personnel, such as Admissions, Student Financial Services and Finance/Investments. Based on the foregoing facts and information, the committee advises and recommends potential changes to policies and procedures for consideration by the Monogram Club Board of Directors.

The current policy adopted by the Monogram Club Board of Directors provides for a minimum award of \$1,000 up to a maximum award of 75% of tuition annually for each eligible and qualified BBSF recipient. The primary focus and intent of the committee and the board is to ensure that members of the Monogram Club are aware of the opportunity to seek financial assistance for their children who attend Notre Dame. It is hoped that the future growth of the BBSF will permit an increase in the total amount of financial assistance.

MONOGRAM CLUB *Honorary Member*

The Monogram Club will use the following procedures for the selection of Honorary Members:

- (1) Procure record of assistance to Notre Dame and its student-athletes and graduate-athletes and/or Notre Dame's athletic programs.
- (2) Persons must be of excellent character worthy of the award as an Honorary Member of the Monogram Club. It is not necessary that the nominee be an alumnus of Notre Dame.
- (3) Recommended by a monogram winner. The recommendations should be by letter to the President of the Monogram Club, c/o Executive Director, outlining the qualifications of the nominee and the reasons justifying the recommendation. The letters should enclose a biographical sketch.
- (4) The recommendation should be endorsed by a minimum of three monogram winners in the area where the nominee resides. These endorsements should be in the form of letters to the President of the Monogram Club with copies to the Executive Director.
- (5) If the nominee resides in an area away from Notre Dame and the recommendation is being made by a monogram winner in that area, a letter from the local Notre Dame Alumni Club President endorsing the nomination should also be directed to the Monogram Club President, c/o Executive Director. The above material must be submitted in sufficient time to be presented to the Awards Committee meetings held in conjunction with any of the three annual meetings of the Board of Directors in order that it may make its recommendation to the Board and the Board act on it at any of the Board's three meetings.
- (6) It is contemplated that these awards be national in scope and that they may be made at the Annual Meeting at Notre Dame to nominees in the Notre Dame geographical areas removed from Notre Dame, that is, Dallas, Los Angeles, New York, Detroit, etc. If desirable, the award may be made at the Annual Meeting and subsequently be reenacted at a Notre Dame athletic event and/or at an alumni event or an appropriate major event.

- (7) When possible, the award should be presented by the Monogram Club president. If this is not possible, it may only be made by the president's designated representative.
- (8) Exceptions to these procedures may be made at the discretion of the Board of Directors.
- (9) Executive Privilege - The president of the University, the director of athletics and/or the Monogram Club president may invoke executive privilege to award an honorary monogram. Executive privilege can be invoked by alerting the current president and/or the executive director. To invoke executive privilege, the president/athletics director will recommend to the Monogram Club's executive committee.
