Driving Directions

From Chicago O'Hare: Airport to 294 South. Follow 294 South to 80 East. Follow 80 East to Indiana Toll Road 80/90 East Bound. Follow 80/90 East Bound to exit 77. At ramp make a right hand turn, and immediately move to left lane. At first light turn left onto Douglas Rd. Follow Douglas Rd. for approximately 1 mile. Warren Golf Course will be on your left.

From Chicago Midway: Airport to I-55 North/Stevenson Expressway North. Take Exit 292B and after approximately 5 miles, merge onto I-90 East, towards Indiana. Take Exit 77 on Indiana Toll Road. At ramp make a right hand turn, and immediately move to left lane. At first light turn left onto Douglas Rd. Follow Douglas Rd. for approximately 1 mile. Warren Golf Course will be on your left.

Parking

All team parking will be located in the main parking lot of the Warren Golf Course for participants. One parking pass will be distributed to each institution at registration. Everyone will be required to display their official parking credentials to enter the main parking area. Media and authorized personnel will also need a parking credential to have access in the main parking lot. Volunteers will park in the D2 lot.

Public parking will be available at the D2 Lot on Juniper Rd. Attendants and appropriate signage will assist with tournament parking.

Tournament Information

Admission

The NCAA Division I Men's Central Regional Championships is FREE throughout the championship. Tournament programs will be available for purchase in the Warren Clubhouse.

Registration

The registration area will be set up at the Warren Clubhouse. Each coach must register his team and submit the team's lineup prior to beginning their practice round. Registration will be open during the following hours:

- Tuesday, May 17th 3:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.
- Wednesday, May 18th 7:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.

Entry Fee

There will be a tournament fee of \$55/person applied to all teams and individuals who wish to take full advantage of the meals throughout the week. The fee will cover lunch Wednesday thru Saturday.

Example: The cost of a participating team (5 players) with one coach is a \$330 entry fee. **Please pay at registration and make checks payable to The University of Notre Dame Athletics.**

Teams who choose not to take advantage of the meals at Warren Clubhouse will be allowed in the snack bar and able to run a tab.

Meals

Participants and Coaches – Notre Dame will provide the following lunch meal. All meals are included in the team entry fee. Only participants, coaches, and volunteers are eligible for these meals in the snack bar located in the tent outside the Clubhouse. Days and Times are listed below:

- Wednesday thru Saturday 11:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.

Pre-Tournament Banquet

- Wednesday 7:15 p.m. At South Dining hall on Notre Dame Campus

Spectators

Spectators are both welcome and encouraged to attend the championship. They must remain on the cart paths or in the rough at least fifteen (15) yards from the players. There may be **NO** communication between players and spectators that could be deemed as advice of any nature for the duration of each 18 hole round. Spectator regulation signage will be located throughout the golf course, as general rules of golf course etiquette are encouraged. The Warren Clubhouse will be open for spectators and the snack bar will be serving food and beverages each day.

Medical Provisions / Athletic Training

Notre Dame Sports Medicine staff will be on-site throughout the competition to assist with all participants and other necessary medical issues. The training area is located in the Warren Clubhouse. Championship Structure

The NCAA Division I Men's Golf Central Regional is a preliminary round of the NCAA Division I Men's Championship. The NCAA Championship Finals will be held June 1-4, 2005 at Caves Valley Golf Club, Owings Mills, Maryland (Loyola College of Maryland, host).

The Central Regional will consist of a 54-hole tournament with 27 teams and six individual players competing. The low 10 teams and the low two individuals not on those teams will advance to the NCAA Championships. Playoffs and tiebreakers, as set forth in Appendix A of the NCAA Men's Golf Handbook, will be used, to determine advancement to the championships. There shall be no cut of the starting field unless deemed necessary by the Games Committee.

If the 3rd round cannot be completed but the morning wave completes its 54 holes, those scores shall count, regardless whether all teams in the afternoon wave complete their round. If some, but not all, of the teams in the afternoon complete the round, the scores of those teams have posted scores for the 3rd round will count. The round for those teams unable to post a score will not be continued, and the region shall be complete. If a minimum of 36 holes cannot be completed, the games committee will select the regional representatives to the finals, taking into consideration 18-hole scores and other selection criteria.

Practice Round

An 18-hole practice round will be conducted at the Warren Golf Course on Wednesday, May 18th beginning at 8:00 a.m. Specific tee times for participating teams and individual players have been predetermined and will not be altered. Please refer to page 32 in the NCAA Men's Golf Handbook for tee time assignments based on your seeding. All teams will begin their practice round off the No. 1 tee.

In an effort to maintain the conditions of the course and the speed of play, **each participant must wear soft spikes, tee off from the designated tee markers, and play only one ball.** A player may putt more than one ball on the putting green only. Violation of this policy will result in the player and/or team being removed from the golf course.

Teams are limited to five (5) players during the practice round. Groups of six are not allowed, and coaches are not allowed to play during the practice round. Head coaches or a designated official

institution representative will be required to be with their team during the entire round. **Coaches are responsible for monitoring pace of play, misconduct and enforcement of the one-ball rule.**

Coaches Meeting

Following the practice round, each of the participating head coaches will attend a **mandatory** championship meeting at 8:45 p.m. after the banquet in the South Dining Hall. The meeting will review tournament procedures, local rules and items of importance to intercollegiate golf. An assistant coach or other institution representative may substitute for the Head Coach with prior approval from the NCAA Golf Committee. A fine of \$100 will be assessed for violation of this policy. The South Dining Hall is located in the South Quad on the main campus of Notre Dame.

Pre-Tournament Banquet

The pre-tournament dinner will be held for players and coaches on Wednesday, May 18th at approximately 7:15 p.m. The event will take place in the South Dining Hall. Dress is casual. Tickets will not be available to the public.

Practice Areas

The practice areas, including driving range, putting greens, practice bunkers and chipping greens, will be open one hour prior to the first tee times of Rounds 1-3. They will open at 6:30 a.m. on the day of the practice round. The practice facilities will close each day at 7:30 p.m. except at 6:30 p.m. the day of the practice round.

Practice Prohibition

Participants and coaches are prohibited from any use and/or visitation of the Championships Golf Course for the 10-day period prior to the competition. No exceptions will be made to this policy; the host institution's team is exempt from this policy.

Golf club repair will be available at the Warren Clubhouse. Please see Brady Wilson for assistance or call 574/631-9383.

All credentials and parking passes will be issued in accordance with NCAA guidelines and may not be mailed. Credential pick-up will be available at the Notre Dame, Joyce Center Sports Information office on Monday, May 16th through Wednesday, May 18th and at the Warren Clubhouse on Thursday, May 19th through Saturday, May 21st.

Tournament Publicity

Sports Information contacts from the qualifying institutions are requested to forward team information, media guides and/or postseason guides including season results to Chris Masters at the address noted above.

Media Services

The media workroom will be located in the Warren Clubhouse. Notre Dame will provide round-by-round results in the media workroom and via fax. Tournament notes and quotes from selected participants will also be produced. Copying, faxing, phone and Internet (Ethernet, wireless, and dial-up) services will be provided in this area to credentialed members of the media and coaches.

The media workroom will also serve as the post-competition interview area for participants and coaches. Coaches are requested to make themselves and their team members available for post-competition interviews upon request for a 10-minute cooling off period.

Results

Tournament results will be compiled using the official GolfStat scoring software. Copies of the day's results will be distributed to every Head Coach after the completion of each round. In addition to the round-by-round results, Notre Dame will maintain running leader boards located on the course and at the Warren Clubhouse. Live scoring will also be available via the Internet at www.und.com and www.golfstat.com, with complete final results at www.ncaasports.com.

Evacuation Plan

In the event of inclement weather, air horns will be used to signal the stoppage of play with 3 separate blasts. One continuous blast will be the signal for the “all clear.”

All participants that are within one hole of the clubhouse (Holes 1, 6, 7, 9, 10, 15, 16 and 18) will be allowed to walk in to the clubhouse. There will be evacuation vans located on the golf course to act as shelters for participants on holes not within one hole of the clubhouse. Locations follow:

- Between #2 green and #5 tee for participants only. (Holes 2, 3, and 5)
- Between #4 tee and #13 tee for participants only. (Holes 4, 12, 5, and 13)
- Between #11 tee, #14 green and #15 tee. (Holes 11, 14, 10, and 15)
- Off to the right of the fairway on #17. (Hole 17)
- Between #7 green and #8 tee. (Holes 7 and 8)

In the event of severe weather the vans will be mobilized and the participants will be shuttled in to the clubhouse. No accommodations are in place for spectators.

Sports Medicine

There will be a certified athletic trainer located in the Warren Clubhouse beginning 1 hour and 15 minutes before the first tee time each day. The following modalities will be provided: Hydroculator (moist heat), combo ultrasound/stem unit, ice, biohazard supplies and taping supplies. In addition to the Notre Dame trainer on site during all practice and competition rounds, a physician will be on call. For additional needs, please contact Skip Meyer at (574)532-4186.
