• Villanova picked up two victories over ranked teams last week. On Wednesday, the Wildcats downed No. 20 Notre Dame at the Pavilion. They followed that on Saturday with a 76-69 triumph over No. 23 Texas at the Wachovia Center. VU is now 2-1 against the Top 25 in 2006-07.

• Freshman Scottie Reynolds has been on an offensive tear of late. The Herndon, Va., native has averaged 21.5 ppg over his last five games, including 53 points in the wins over Notre Dame and Texas. He ranks third on the Wildcats in scoring at 11.8 ppg.

• Senior forward Curtis Sumpter remains day-to-day with a deep bone bruise on his left tibia. The native of Brooklyn, N.Y. suffered the injury in last week's win over Notre Dame and received treatment in the days leading up to Saturday's clash with Texas. However, he did not see action against the Horns, missing his first contest of 2006-07.

• Villanova meets Notre Dame for the second time in 10 days on Saturday afternoon at 4:00 p.m. (ESPN2). The 'Cats will return home after the contest to begin preparation for a Monday night date with Pittsburgh at the Wachovia Center (7:00 p.m./ESPN).

2006-07 MEN'S BASKETBALL GAME NOTES

Toppled Texas

One year ago, the Wachovia Center was home to some of Villanova's most defining moments. It was at the Center that the Wildcats upended top ranked Connecticut and later where they won a pair of NCAA Tournament contests.

On Saturday, the 2006-07 Wildcats crafted a memory of their own before 18,742 at the Center and a national television audience. Playing without All-American candidate Curtis Sumpter for the first time this season, Villanova authored a gritty 76-69 victory over No. Texas.

"Give Villanova a lot of credit," stated Longhorns coach Rick Barnes. "They played with a lot of effort and passion."

"It was a great effort by our guys," added Villanova head coach Jay Wright.

Points were hard to come by in the first half for both teams. Longhorns freshman sensation Kevin Durant scored 11 points but the rest of his teammates only added 12 and Villanova entered intermission with a 26-23 edge.

The Wildcats were able to ignite their offense in the second half while also keeping Durant under wraps. The sensational rookie, who averaged 34 ppg in his previous three outings, came up with only one second half point as the 'Cats fought off a late charge to win 76-69 in large part by limiting the Longhorns to .355 shooting from the field.

"They played great team defense," stated Durant. It wasn't just one or two guys. They had two guys in my face all the time."

Sumpter Summary

His medical history doesn't quite rival that of his good friend and former teammate Jason Fraser. But in his four plus seasons at Villanova, 6-7 senior Curtis Sumpter has seen all too much time in the training room.

Lately, he has been vexed by two nagging injuries. A right hamstring injury bothered him through the early part of the month, forcing him to miss significant practice time. Then, in a Jan. 17 win over Notre Dame, Sumpter suffered a deep bone bruise on his right tibia that forced him to miss Saturday's win over Texas.

On the court Sumpter has demonstrated no ill effects from the two surgeries he endured in 2005 to repair a torn ACL on his left knee. The native of Brooklyn, N.Y., has dropped in 20 or more points on eight different occasions and been among the BIG EAST's top three scorers all season.

A key barometer on Sumpter's affect on the Wildcats can be found in the free throw shooting statistics. That he reached the line five times against Notre Dame, converting four, was a good omen for the 'Cats. When Sumpter - a .798 hooter from the stripe - reaches the line five or more times this season, Villanova is 9-1 (.900). When he fails to reach that number, the Wildcats are 3-4 (.426).

In VU's five losses this season, Sumpter has attempted only 15 free throws.

Sumpter is connecting on .482 of his field goal attempts and hits from beyond the 3-point arc at a .407 clip.

Noting Nardi

In the view of Wright, quantifying the contributions of senior guard Mike Nardi is no simple task.

"He's done everything we've asked of him," Wright told the Newark Star-Ledger. "We've asked him to groom a freshman guard (Scottie Reynolds), be a leader for 10 freshmen and sophomores, play 36 minutes a game, defend, rebound and also be the brains of our operation. And he has done all of it."

Against Texas, Nardi made several key plays to help the 'Cats. His nifty pass led to a Dante Cunningham dunk that brought the crowd to its feet in the second half. Then, he grabbed two critical rebounds in the final minute to help secure the win. He ended the day with 13 points.

This native of Linden, N.J. has been one of Villanova's most reliable performers over his career. He now has started 110 times in 114 appearances and became the 49th player in school history to reach the 1,000 point barrier at Penn on Dec. 2 (he is now at 1,151 points).

In addition, the 6-2 guard is one of the more accomplished distributors in Villanova history. He now has 381 career assists, good for 15th place on the school's all-time list. He needs 12 to tie Whitey Rigsby in 14th place.

In recent weeks, he has been especially reliable as a ball-handler. In his last 10 outings, beginning on Dec. 9 against Drexel, Nardi has accumulated 45 assists and committed just 17 turnovers.

Reynolds Wrap

He arrived at Villanova this fall as the Wildcats' most prominent incoming freshman and, of late, guard Scottie Reynolds has begun to assert himself offensively.

This native of Herndon, Va., is Villanova's leading scorer in BIG EAST action (17.8 ppg) and has reached double figures in eight of the 'Cats last nine games, including 26 against Texas. This followed a 27 point effort in a win over Notre Dame at the Pavilion on Jan. 17.

Reynolds originally signed with Oklahoma, before electing to re-open his recruitment in the spring of 2006 after coach Kelvin Sampson accepted a new position at Indiana. He chose Villanova in late May, becoming the 'Cats first McDonald's All-American since Jason Fraser.

On the season, he is third on the squad in scoring at 11.8 ppg and is 26-of-73 (.356) from outside the 3-point arc. As one of Villanova's primary ball-handlers he has 71 assists (3.8 apg) thus far and 48 turnovers.

In Villanova's first 12 outings this season, Reynolds attempted 75 field goals - an average of 6.2 per contest. In his last six games, he has attempted 77 - 12.6 per contest.

Reynolds converted 21-of-23 (.913) from the line in his last two games and is connecting at an .816 clip on the year. His 76 attempts are second among the Wildcats to Sumpter.

Under Pressure

Last season, Villanova utilized speed and quickness to apply defensive pressure to its opponents. This year it has added a new element: length. With a regular nine-man rotation featuring only two athletes under 6-5, the 'Cats can create mischief with traps at nearly any point on the floor.

In its 18 games this season, there have been six times when the Wildcats have forced an opponent into 20 or more turnovers.

On the season, VU's foes have committed 320 turnovers, an average of 17.8 per game.

Dante's Delivered

Like his fellow product of the metropolitan Washington, D.C., area, Scottie Reynolds, Dante Cunningham is more than willing to cede the spotlight to his senior teammates. Through November and December, the Villanova coaching staff kept prodding him to be more assertive offensively, especially in the low post.

To understand why one needs look no further than this: when Cunningham attempts four or more field goals in a game this season, Villanova is 12-0. When he has been limited to three or less, the 'Cats are just 1-5.

Cunningham's offense played a major role in both wins last week. He followed a 19 point, nine rebound effort in the win over Notre Dame with a 16 point, six rebound day against the Longhorns, punctuated by a thundering second half dunk. What's more, he supplied his typical sticky defense to Durant and, along with Shane Clark, help limit the damage Texas' prize rookie could do.

"We are trying to get Dante, Scottie and Shane to understand that the seniors don't care about who gets credit," says Wright.

As a rookie last season, Cunningham averaged 2.2 points and 4.0 rebounds per game mostly as a reserve. Despite those modest figures, a measure of the 6-8 sophomore's value was seen when he was selected as the Philadelphia Big Five Rookie of the Year for his contributions to a 28-5 unit

This season, the native of Silver Spring, Md., has had more opportunities to shine and is taking advantage. He is 62-of-94 (.660) from the field this season, which ranks second in the BIG EAST to Providence's Herbert Hill.

Pavilion Percentages

The Pavilion has been a most comfortable home for the Wildcats since opening on Feb. 1, 1986.

In 22 seasons, the 'Cats are 185-54 (.773) in the building on Ithan Avenue. They are 80-35 (.653) in BIG EAST action in the Pavilion and have sold out the last 68 consecutive regular season contests in the 6,500 seat venue. From 1994-95 forward, VU is 124-22 (.849) overall in the Pavilion.

Since Jay Wright assumed the head coaching reins in 2001, Villanova is 53-12 (.815) on its Pavilion floor. It is 24-4 (.858) in the arena since the start of 2004-05 with the losses coming to Georgetown (2005), West Virginia and Drexel (2006) and DePaul (2007). It had a 13-game winning streak against non-conference foes snapped when it fell to the Dragons 81-76 on Dec. 9.

Visitors to the Pavilion will note the construction in what formerly was the front parking area. Work has begun on the Intercollegiate Athletic Recreation Facility, which will house practice courts and office space for the men's and women's programs. The project is scheduled for completion in the fall of 2007.

The Wildcats will also host a school record five games this season at the Wachovia Center in Philadelphia. Villanova is 16-16 (.500) lifetime in the arena as host and 2-0 (1.000) in NCAA Tournament action in the building. The Wildcats defeated Texas 76-69 on Jan. 20 to run their Center win streak to six straight.

Philadelphia Big Five

Villanova is again participating in the Philadelphia tradition known as the Big Five. The Wildcats, who swept the City Series last year, are scheduled to face four local rivals this season. They opened Big Five play on Dec. 2 with a 99-89 win at Penn, their eighth consecutive victory in Big Five play. Villanova followed that with a 64-51 win at La Salle on Dec. 23. One week later, the 'Cats posted an 83-65 win over Temple to move to 3-0.

The final collision in the City Series comes on Feb. 6 when Saint Joseph's and Villanova clash at the Pavilion. ESPN2 will broadcast the game nationally as part of its annual "Rivalry Week" series.

Shane's Story

After spending this season's first 17 games as Villanova's sixth man, Shane Clark received his first career start when Sumpter was forced to the sidelines with a bone bruise. The 6-7 forward did not disappoint, posting his second double-double of his career with 11 points and 12 rebounds along with some excellent defense when matched with Durant.

"All of Philadelphia has been waiting for this and Shane has too," said Jay Wright. "He is a very good basketball player who has just been bothered by a series of nagging injuries."

Clark was bothered by left knee inflammation in the pre-season and then injured his right elbow last week at Syracuse. Yet he has persevered and become a valuable weapon for the Wildcats.

How valuable?

The 'Cats are 9-1 (.900) this season when the 6-7 swingman contributes nine or more points to the cause.

"Shane is our Kyle," says Sumpter. "He comes in there, gets a big rebound or a big basket and gives us a lift."

The product of Cardinal Dougherty High School and Hargrave Military Academy averages 8.9 points and 3.9 rebounds a game.

Will's Grace

Senior forward Will Sheridan has been an integral component in Villanova's success over the course of the past three seasons, though his role is sometimes overlooked. No statistic is more telling than this: in games Sheridan has started Villanova is 66-18 (.785) during his career.

In the triumph over Texas, Sheridan contributed six points, seven rebounds and an impressive blocked shot against Durant.

Sheridan has started all 18 games and often draws the toughest interior defensive assignment. He averages 6.4 points and 5.5 rebounds per game. His 26 blocked shots lead Villanova (1.4 bpg).

The man from Bear, Del., known to all on campus as 'Bump', is also one of Villanova's leading citizens who has been involved in NCAA Leadership Conferences; wrote a column for the Philadelphia Daily News during VU's 2006 NCAA Tournament appearance; served on the committee that planned the inauguration of new university president Rev. Peter Donohue, O.S.A., in September; and has won the athletic department's annual "Talent Show".

Defensive Details

At the root of the victory over Texas was hard-nosed defense. The 'Cats limited an explosive offensive unit to 22-of-62 (.355) shooting from the floor. It was the sixth time this season that Villanova has limited a foe to 40 percent shooting or less from the floor and the 'Cats are 6-0 in that circumstance.

Honoring its Past

The No. 11 black patch Villanova wears on its uniform honors the memory of Paul Arizin, who died last month at the age of 78.

Arizin enrolled at Villanova in 1946 but played only intramural basketball as a freshman. He was invited on to the squad as a sophomore and became the national player of the year in 1950. He then became a 10-time NBA All-Star and was named one of the league's 50 Greatest Players. His jersey and No. 11 are retired and hang in the Pavilion rafters.

The Wildcats lost another Villanova icon when former team chaplain (1978-2004) Father Bernard Lazor, O.S.A., died at the age of 81 on Jan. 14.

Coming Attractions

Villanova signed three student-athletes in November who are scheduled to enroll in the fall of 2007.

Three talented guards have signed national letters of intent to attend Villanova University. The class includes 6-1 Corey Fisher of St. Patrick's (N.J.) High School; 6-0 Malcolm Grant of The Winchendon School (Mass.); and 6-5 Corey Stokes of St. Benedict's (N.J.) Prep.

"We are thrilled to have three more East Coast guards that are outstanding players and beautiful people join our family at Villanova," stated Villanova head coach Jay Wright in making the announcement on Nov. 14. "We are extremely impressed by the pedigree of these three guards. They all come to us from exceptionally strong and tradition-laden programs."

Fisher, a native of the Bronx, N.Y., helped lead St. Patrick's High School to the New Jersey Tournament of Champions title last March. He was a first team all-state choice by Newark Star Ledger after averaging 14.9 points and 4.2 assists per outing in 2005-06. Fisher hails from the same high school as current 'Cat senior Mike Nardi.

"Corey Fisher is extremely well-prepared for college basketball after playing for coach Kevin Boyle at St. Pat's," said Wright. "Corey is in the same mold as Mike Nardi, as he is both explosive and intelligent on the court."

Grant scored over 1,500 points in a decorated high school career at Brooklyn (N.Y.)'s Paul Robeson High School before enrolling at Winchendon this fall. As a senior at Robeson in 2005-06, Grant averaged 23.0 points, 2.6 rebounds and 2.0 assists per contest.

"Malcolm comes from a great high school program at Robeson where he was coached by Todd Miles and followed that this season in another great program at Winchendon, coached by Mike Byrnes," Wright stated. "Malcolm is a true point guard. He is crafty, tenacious and very charismatic."

Stokes was an integral component of another potent New Jersey squad in 2005-06, St. Benedict's Prep. He averaged 11.5 ppg as part of a balanced attack, connecting on 42 percent of his 3-point field goal attempts and joined Fisher on the first team all-state squad. One of Stokes' former teammates, sophomore Frank Tchuisi, is already a member of the Wildcats squad.

"Corey is probably one of the best shooters we have ever recruited at Villanova," said Wright. "He has also been very well coached by Danny Hurley at St. Benedict's Prep. Corey brings size, toughness and a great basketball IQ."

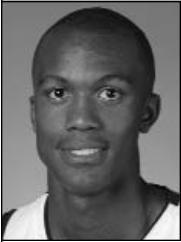

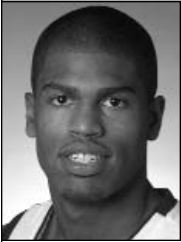
