## FOOTBALL STUDENT SEATING

Student seating at Peden Stadium is general admission in the areas shown below on the Peden Stadium seating diagram. O Zone members wearing their shirts are permitted to sit in sections 10, 11, 15, & 16 while seating is available, but come early... Those seats fill up fast!

## ADMISSION

Students are admitted to ALL Ohio Athletics home events FREE of charge. Football tickets can be picked up during the week prior to each football game at 3 locations on campus:

**The Convocation Center Ticket Office** - 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. (Located in the lobby on the concourse level)

**All 5 Campus Dining Halls** - Boyd, Bromley, Jefferson, Nelson, & Shively during regular operational hours (See the attendant who swipes ID's.)

**The Ping Center** - At the front desk during designated hours

Admission to volleyball, men's & women's basketball, baseball and softball can be gained by showing your student ID at the gate. All other events are free to the general public and no ID is required.

## PURCHASING ADDITIONAL TICKETS FOR FAMILY & GUESTS

Additional tickets can be purchased at the Convocation Center Ticket Office for your family and friends when they will be in town to visit. Single game tickets are \$15 and can also be ordered over the phone or online with a credit card.

## MOVE-IN WITH OHIO FOOTBALL!

Don't miss your chance to take your family to the first football game of the season. The Bobcats open the season at Peden Stadium against Tenn.-Martin at 7 p.m. on Saturday, Sept. 2. After you get unpacked and settled in, head over to the game. **All parents and family members of students can purchase discounted tickets for this game only for \$5 each.** Just present your student ID at the ticket window on game-day to take advantage of this offer!

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

**Do I need a ticket to come to the game or can I just get in with my student ID?**

If you do not have a ticket before you arrive to Peden Stadium on game day, you will be given one at the gate WHILE SUPPLIES LAST.

**If I have picked up my student ticket before the game, do I still need to bring my student ID with me to the game?**

Yes, you still need to bring your student ID with you, even if you have already picked up your ticket before the game.

**Peden Stadium is a big place. What gate am I supposed to enter?**

The student gate is Gate 4, located on the northeast side of the stadium, closest to the Ping Center.

**But my parents are with me... Can I get in with my student ticket at Gate 1, 2 or 3?**

Unfortunately, if you are using a student ticket, you must enter at Gate 4 because all student IDs must be verified at that location. However, your guests may enter at Gate 4 with you.



**THE O ZONE** is Ohio Athletics' premiere student cheering section. Now in its sixth year, the O Zone has a strong reputation for its loyal support of the Bobcats, along with its fierce intimidation of opponents. And the sixth year brings new and exciting changes that will help to make the group stronger (and louder) than ever!

## WHAT ARE THE PERKS?

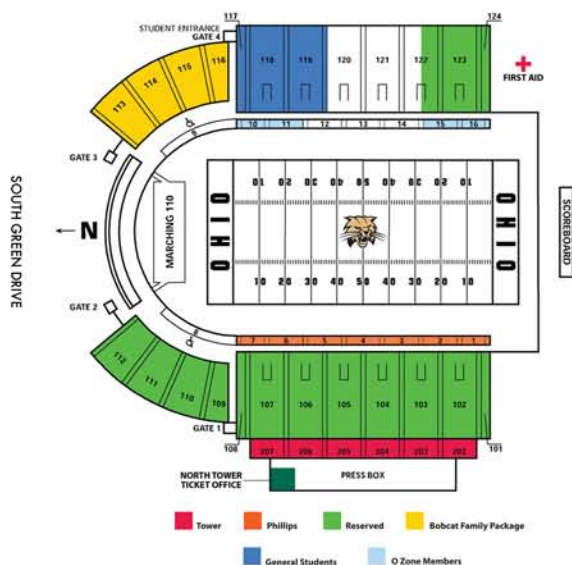
