FRIARS vs. SIENA SAINTS

The Providence College women's basketball team won their second-straight game defeating Siena College, 77-66, on Saturday. Senior **Monika Roberts** led the Friars with her second double-double of the season, scoring 16 points and grabbing 13 rebounds in the victory. The 6'2" senior also added three assists and a season-high 4 blocked shots in 32 minutes. Freshman **Jenese Wilcox**

recorded her second double-double of the season as well, posting 10 points and 12 rebounds for Providence. Freshman **Kristin Qiunn** added a career-high 13 points and added a career-high-tying four assists in her second start of the season.

COACHING MILESTONE

Providence College Head Coach **Jim Jabir** is one win from earning his 200th career coaching victory. With a win tonight against Fairfield University, Jabir would reach this personal milestone.

WILCOX BIG EAST ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Providence College freshman center **Jenese Wilcox (Port Chester, N.Y.)** was named the BIG EAST Conference's Rookie of the Week on Monday, November 20th. Wilcox posted her first career double-double in the Friars 78-55 win over Central Michigan on Saturday, November 18th. The 6'2" rookie scored a career-high 13 points and grabbed seven rebounds in PC's 88-60 loss to the University of Minnesota on Sunday, November 19th. For the week, Wilcox averaged 12 points, 9.5 rebounds, an assist and steal and 0.5 blocked shots per game.

FRIARS WIN SEASON'S FIRST PRESEASON GAME

The Providence College Friars won their season-opening exhibition contest over Bryant College, 57-49, on Saturday, November 4th at PC's Alumni Hall. Senior **Jen Gombotz** led the Friars with 15 points in the win, while freshman **Jenese Wilcox** added 12 points and 10 rebounds plus two steals and two blocked shots in her collegiate debut.

FRIARS FINISH PRESEASON PERFECT

The Providence College women's basketball team finished the preseason with a perfect 2-0 record after defeating Sweden's Eos Malbas, 85-74, on Friday, November 10th. Senior **Jen Gombotz** led the Friars with 17 points and added eight rebounds, three steals and two assists. A trio of freshmen, **Jenese Wilcox**, **Kristin Quinn** and **Ryann Kilgore** rounded out the PC players who scored in double figures. Wilcox scored 14 points, grabbed eight rebounds and added three steals, two blocked shots and an assist. Quinn chipped in with 13 points and added six rebounds and five steals. Kilgore scored 10 points and added four rebounds and three assists.

FRIARS OPEN 26TH BASKETBALL SEASON

With Providence's win over Central Michigan at the 2000 Sheraton Four Points Basketball Classic at the University of Minnesota begins the start of Providence College's 26th season of women's basketball. The Friars have amassed a career record of **453-282 (0.616)** in their 26th season.

HEAD COACH JIM JABIR

Jim Jabir is in his fifth season at the helm of the Providence College basketball squad. After four successful recruiting campaigns with the Friars, Jabir looks to begin a successful chapter. Jabir owns a career record of **199-194 (0.506)** in 15 years as a Division I head coach. The personable and well-liked Jabir is dedicated to the program and to its resurgence in the BIG EAST.

Providence College welcomed Jabir into the Friar family on May 21, 1996 as he was named the sixth head coach in the 22-year history of the program.

In 14 seasons as a collegiate head coach, eight of his teams have posted winning records. In the last four seasons, the Friars have taken important steps toward rebuilding. In 1996-97, the Friars posted a 13-13 regular season record and lost to Villanova in the first round of the BIG EAST Championship. The following season, PC went 10-17 and exited the BIG EAST Tournament in the first round at the hands of Boston College. Injuries played a role in the win to loss ratio during the 1998-99 season as the Friars found themselves at a 5-22 overall record when the BIG EAST Tournament ended with a 68-69 loss to Villanova. Last season, PC was still plagued with injuries but doubled their win total from last year with a 10-17 overall mark.

Prior to coming to Providence, Jabir spent six years at Marquette, becoming the most successful coach in the history of the program and elevated the Golden Eagles into the national spotlight.

Under his high-powered, run-and-gun offense, Jabir established a program that earned respect from people in Milwaukee, in the nation and in the ranks of women's basketball.

After posting a 7-20 record during his inaugural year (1990-91) at Marquette, Jabir guided his team to four consecutive winning seasons, two 20-plus winning seasons and three straight post-season appearances including back-to-back bids to the NCAA Tournament. In 1994-95, Marquette won the Great Midwest Conference Tournament, the first tournament championship in school history. This followed the 1993-94 season in which Jabir compiled a program-best 22-7 overall record and its first trip to the NCAA Tournament.

Just four years after Jabir's arrival at Marquette, the program made its way onto the national scene as it earned its first-ever trip to the NCAA Tournament. Seeded 14th, Marquette was four points

shy of pulling off an upset over No. 5 Colorado. The Lady Buffs needed three last-second free throws to earn the 77-74 victory.

In 1994-95 Marquette received a No. 10 seed and the chance to play No. 7 seed North Carolina State on a neutral court at Penn State. Despite a grand effort, a late Golden Eagle rally came up short as MU fell to the Wolfpack, 77-62.

Jabir matriculated to Marquette from Siena College, where he served as the head coach of the Lady Saints for three seasons (1987-90) and compiled a 50-20 overall record. Jabir's teams posted three consecutive winning seasons and his 1989-90 team was a semifinalist in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) post-season tournament.

Prior to his stint at Siena, Jabir was the head coach at Buffalo State during the 1986-87 season at the young age of 24. He led that team to a 14-11 record. Jabir guided the Bengals to the State University of New York Athletic Conference (SUNYAC) championship and an appearance in the NCAA Division III South Regional Tournament.

The Brooklyn, N.Y. native began his coaching career as an assistant at Nazareth College (1984-85) and at Buffalo State (1985-86). Jabir was instrumental in leading the Bengals to a 23-3 slate, the SUNYAC title, a 22-game winning streak, an NCAA regional tournament appearance and a national ranking (#3) during the 1985-86 season.

Jabir, tabbed by Basketball Times as one of the top 10 up-and-coming coaches in the country, was a two-time Reebok/Great Midwest Conference Coach of the Year.

He is a member of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association and a previous board member of the New York State Basketball Coaches.

A well-known speaker in New York, Pennsylvania and New England, Jabir and his wife, Kathy, have three children, Lauren, Shane and Jackson.
