## 2006 Final Notes

### SIU Salukis (35-13, 15-6 MVC)

#### SOFTBALL MAKES FOURTH CONSECUTIVE NCAA TOURNAMENT; FINISHES SEASON WITH 35-13 RECORD

Despite battling the weather for most of the season, the Southern Illinois University softball team managed to put together an impressive 35-13 record, garnering an at-large bid to the NCAA Tournament - the team's fourth straight appearance.

SIU lost to host Northwestern in the first game of the NCAA Regional in Evanston, Ill., 4-0. All four Wildcat runs were unearned.

The Salukis followed up the loss with a 2-1 win over the University of California-Santa Barbara to advance to an elimination game with Notre Dame.

SIU led throughout most of the contest over the Fighting Irish, but a sixth-inning surge put Notre Dame back in the game, eventually leading to the 5-4 Saluki loss.

#### CLIFTON AND STEIN NAMED ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICANS

For the first time since 1992, the SIU softball team placed multiple players on the CoSIDA/ESPN The Magazine Academic All-America teams.

Clifton earned second team honors as a catcher. She batted .315 in 2006 with a 3.94 GPA. She is majoring in accounting and management information systems.

Stein made the third team after batting .314 this season with a 4.00 GPA. She is majoring in public relations.

Only six other players have earned academic All-America honors while at SIU.

#### SIU PLACES SIX ON MVC SCHOLAR-ATHLETE TEAM

Just as it did on the field, the SIU softball team dominated the roster of the Missouri Valley Conference Scholar-Athlete team, placing six on the team - the most for SIU since 2001.

Amanda Clifton, Lauren Haas, Cassidy Scoggins and Krystal Stein all made it to the first team while Katie Louis and Lauren Roney were named honorable mention.

#### SCOGGINS AND STEIN EARN ALL-REGION HONORS FOR SECOND YEAR

Junior pitcher Cassidy Scoggins and sophomore outfielder Krystal Stein earned their way on to one of the Great Lakes All-Region teams, the NFCA announced Wednesday, May 17.

Scoggins earned her way on to the first team after posting a 25-10 record in 2006 with a 1.10 ERA and 226 strikeouts.

Stein makes her way on to the second team after hitting .330 in 2006 with five doubles and three triples.

#### DAWGS MAKE FOURTH-STRAIGHT NCAA REGIONAL TOURNAMENT

With the announcement coming on Selection Sunday, the Salukis found out that they would be going to their fourth NCAA Regional Tournament in as many years.

SIU has five NCAA Tournament appearances (1991, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006) and sports a 7-8 record.

#### SIU FINISHES THIRD IN THE VALLEY; SWEEPED OUT OF MVC TOURNEY

The Southern Illinois University softball team found itself in an unfamiliar place this year as it finished third in the Missouri Valley Conference after back-to-back years as league champions.

With its 15-6 Valley record, the Salukis finished behind regular season champion Illinois State (19-4) and Missouri State (18-4). MSU came back to win the MVC Tournament in Omaha, Neb., defeating Wichita State in the championship game.

SIU was swept out of the MVC Tournament, dropping both of its game in the double-elimination format. The Salukis fall in 10 innings to host Creighton, 2-1 in the opening game of the tournament before falling to Drake, 4-1.

## SCOGGINS EARNS MVC PITCHER OF THE YEAR, FIVE SALUKIS EARN POSTSEASON HONORS

Junior pitcher Cassidy Scoggins was named MVC Pitcher of the Year at the MVC Tournament Banquet, held May 10 in Omaha, Neb. The junior finished the regular season with a 0.91 ERA and 218 strikeouts to go along with her 25-8 record. This marks the second year that SIU takes Pitcher of the Year honors as Amy Harre earned it in 2005.

## CLIFTON AND RONEY MAKE MVC ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

For their performance in the MVC Tournament, held May 11-13 in Omaha, Neb., senior Lauren Roney and junior Amanda Clifton were rewarded with spots on the MVC All-Tournament Team.

Roney's highlight came in a 1-for-3 performance against Creighton in the opening game as she hit a RBI single to score the Salukis' only run of the game, at the time giving SIU the lead.

Clifton hit a solo home run in the 4-1 loss to Drake, her fifth of the season, scoring SIU's lone run.

## HOME SWEET HOME

The Salukis wrapped up their home schedule April 22 with a split against Creighton, finished the 2006 season with a 20-2 home record. The .909 winning percentage is the best ever in the facility. SIU posted a 10-3 record at Charlotte West Stadium in its inaugural year, followed it up with a 22-4 record in 2004 and finished with a 17-3 record last season.

## SCOGGINS NAMED LOUISVILLE SLUGGER/NFCA NATIONAL PLAYER OF THE WEEK (4/19)

After going a perfect 5-0 in the circle pitcher Cassidy Scoggins was named the Louisville Slugger / National Fastpitch Coaches Association National Division I Player of the Week on April 19.

It marks the second time in Scoggins' career that she has earned the honor. She was named Louisville Slugger / NFCA National Player of the Week on April 20, 2005.

Scoggins struck out 36 batters over the 28 innings that she pitched. She pitched three complete-game shutout wins while picking up two wins in relief appearances.

Opponents hit just .132 against the junior from Owasso, Okla. over the week. In the opening game against Indiana State last week, Scoggins hurled 12 strikeouts, one shy of her career high and the fifth time this season that she has pitched double-digit strikeouts.

## SCOGGINS NAMED MVC PITCHER OF THE WEEK (3/20 & 4/17)

Twice this season, SIU junior pitcher Cassidy Scoggins has been named Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week.

On March 20, she earned the honor following her three-win performance against Northern Iowa in the opening weekend of MVC play.

The junior from Owasso, Okla. earned the win for SIU in all three games. She pitched two complete game shutout wins and entered the game in relief for Ashley Hamby in the other game to get the win.

During her 12.1 innings of action, Scoggins compiled a 0.00 ERA while striking out 20 batters. She walked five Panthers and gave up only four hits in the three appearances.

She picked up the honor again on April 16 after going 5-0, never allowing a run in all five appearances.

She struck out 36 batters while walking only one in 28 innings pitched. Opponents had a .132 hitting percentage during the stretch.

## HAAS NAMED MVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK (4/17)

After having a dominating week at the plate, sophomore Lauren Haas earned MVC Player of the Week honors for the first time in her career, April 16.

In SIU's five games, Haas batted .467 (7-for-15) with a 1.067 slugging percentage.

Of her seven hits, she had a double, a triple and two home runs while also leading the team in RBI with seven.

Her two home runs give her 12 for her career, placing her in a tie for ninth at SIU in career home runs.

## SCOGGINS NETS 50th CAREER WIN

With her 5-2 complete-game win over Missouri State in the second game of last weekend's three-

game series, SIU junior pitcher Cassidy Scoggins picked up her 50th career win.

The Owasso, Okla. native is now tied for sixth all-time at SIU in career wins. She earned 13 wins as a freshman, 20 as a sophomore and 23 so far this season.

In her three seasons at SIU she has compiled a 57-17 record, for a .770 winning percentage, along with six career saves. In that time she has also pitched 25 shutouts, four of which were no-hitters.

## LOUIS NAMED MVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK (4/3)

After batting .462 (6-for-13) in five games against UT Martin and Illinois State, senior Katie Louis was named MVC Player of the Week April 3.

The O'Fallon, Ill. native hit two doubles and two home runs over the span of the five games. Her four extra-base hits gave her a slugging percentage of 1.077. She also drew three walks for a .563 on-base percentage.

Louis also contributed directly on two of SIU's wins. She scored the game-winning run in the second game against UT Martin and hit the game-winning RBI in the third game against Illinois State.

She is the first Saluki to receive the honor this season.

## DOUBLE DOWN

In the three-game sweep over UNI, one thing that kept going for SIU was extra-base hits.

In the first game of the series, the SIU softball team tallied five doubles against the Panthers - tying a SIU single-game record.

In the third game of the series, sophomore Becky Wegmann chalked up two doubles, also tying a SIU single-game individual record.

Senior Katie Louis joined Wegmann in that honor April 1 as she hit two doubles in the second game of the doubleheader against Illinois State. For Louis it was the third time in her career that she has accomplished the feat.

## GRAND-SLAMMING IT

SIU senior Katie Louis hit the team's first grand slam of the season Feb. 24 in the Salukis' 6-4 win over Seton Hall.

With SIU trailing 3-2 and two outs in the bottom of the sixth inning, Louis slammed a home run to left-center, clearing the bases and putting the Salukis in the lead, 6-3.

Freshman Jayme Wamsley joined Louis in the Grand Slam Club April 2 against Illinois State.

With one out and the bases loaded in the bottom of the third inning, Wamsley cranked her third home run of the season over the left-field fence. The home run gave SIU its fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth runs against the Redbirds, helping along the 9-1 five-inning win.

## SALUKIS MOVE INTO TOP 25 (3/21)

Following the March 18-19 sweep over Northern

Iowa, the SIU softball team made its first appearance in the top 25.

In the ESPN.com / USA Softball Top 25 poll released March 21, the Salukis earned 28 votes to make it into the poll at #25. SIU had been receiving votes all throughout the season but had not been able to make the leap into the top 25.

SIU is no stranger to the ESPN.com / USA Softball poll as the Salukis spent eight weeks during the 2005 season ranked in the top 25, earning as high as #20.

## WEATHER ISSUES

Heading into the 2006 season, almost three months ago, the Salukis were planning on a 65-game regular season. Well, the weather had something else in mind.

After having each of its five tournaments this season cut short because of inclement weather and a recent flurry of cancelled games, SIU has only 43 games in the book.

The Triple Crown Classic in St. Augustine, Fla., was cut short because of freezing temperatures. The Mississippi State Invitational was cut short by the Salukis because of rain and potential travel hazards.

The NFCA Leadoff Classic was shortened for the fourth time in six years because of rain. And, this past weekend, the final game of the Kay Brechtelsbauer Southern Classic, against #24 Iowa, was cancelled because of inclement weather and travel schedules.

Then, March 10-12, the National Invitational in Sunnyvale, Calif. was cut short because of rain and field conditions. Following the tournament, SIU's doubleheader with St. Mary's (CA) was cancelled because of a storm system that passed through the area, carrying with it lightning, hail and torrential rain.

After a month-long break from the weather, SIU's final game against Creighton (and final home game of the season) was cancelled because of storms pass-

Then, to go along with the theme from the season, weather forced the cancellation of seven of SIU's last eight games of the season. An entire series against Bradley and a doubleheader against Illinois were cancelled. SIU was able to get in one game in its final three-game series of the season against Wichita State to end the season with 22 cancelled games.

## HAMBY'S STREAK ENDS AT 11 GAMES

Junior pitcher Ashley Hamby's winning streak ended April 1 in an 8-6 loss to MVC rival Illinois State.

Hamby, who had not lost a game since April 27, 2004, went a perfect 4-0 during the 2005 season and carried a 7-0 record for the 2006 season into the game.

## DISMORE HITS DOUBLE DIGITS

Sophomore Tiffanie Dismore holds SIU's longest hitting streak of the 2006 season.

The Lafayette, Ind. native was on a 10-game hitting streak before it ended in the second game of Wednesday's doubleheader with UT Martin.

The streak started March 11 against UC Davis at the National Invitational in San Jose, Calif.

During the streak, Dismore hit .400 (14-for-35) with two doubles, two triples and a home run.

## SALUKI THEIFTS

SIU Head Coach Kerri Blaylock said in the pre-season that this year's team would be quick, but she didn't say how quick.

The Salukis are nearly perfect in stolen bases, stealing 41 on 47 attempts. Twice this season, against Texas Tech and Tennessee State, the Salukis have stolen five bases in a game.

Leading the way for SIU is senior Samantha Carter with perfect 14-for-14 so far this season. Carter set a career best March 12 against San Jose State as she stole three bases in the game.

## BLAYLOCK GETS 250TH CAREER WIN

Entering the season with 239 career wins, it was not going to take long for SIU Head Coach Kerri Blaylock to reach the next win plateau of 250.

And, it would be only fitting that she get the win against the team where she got her coaching start.

On March 7, Blaylock earned her 250th career victory in a 4-0 shutout win over Southeast Missouri at Charlotte West Stadium.

Blaylock started her coaching career at SEMO, working as a graduate assistant from 1988-90.

## SIU WINS KAY BRECHTELSBAUER SOUTHERN CLASSIC

For the second year in a row, Southern Illinois won the Kay Brechtelsbauer Southern Classic.

SIU finished the two-day tournament with a perfect 3-0 record. The Salukis beat Illinois-Chicago (5-2), #24 Iowa (2-1) and Northern Illinois (5-2).

Southern Illinois also won the tournament in 2005, going 3-1 through the weekend. The Salukis

lost to Kansas during the first day of the tournament, but came back to beat the Jayhawks in the championship game.

## MAKE IT 50 AT WEST STADIUM

SIU's 5-2 win over Illinois-Chicago on March 4 marked the 50th victory at Charlotte West Stadium - Rochman Field. The Salukis hold a commanding .839 (52-10) winning percentage at its home complex that opened in 2003.

## HAAS, HAMBY NAMED TO MSU INVITE ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM

Following their performances in SIU's two games at the Mississippi State Invitational, Lauren Haas and Ashley Hamby were named to the MSU Invitational All-Tournament Team.

Haas led SIU offensively in the 8-0 win over Tennessee State. She went 2-for-3 at the plate, scoring a run with two RBI.

Hamby pitched a career-high nine strikeouts in the shutout victory. She faced 21 batters, giving up six hits and only two walks in the game.

## SALUKIS WIN TRIPLE CROWN INVITE

Sporting a 4-0 record, the Southern Illinois softball team took top honors at the Triple Crown Invitational Feb. 10-12 in St. Augustine, Fla.

SIU beat Texas Tech and Central Florida twice each en route to the championship.

## CONNOYER JOINS SIU COACHING STAFF

Christy Connoyer, formerly a head coach and Tulsa and assistant coach at Purdue, joined the Southern Illinois softball coaching staff over the summer of 2005.

Connoyer replaces former assistant Buddy Foster, who left the team to take a head coaching position at MVC-member Bradley University.

A native of Bethalto, Ill., Connoyer was head coach at Tulsa in 2005 after spending eight years as an assistant coach at Purdue.

At SIU, Connoyer works as a hitting coach and with infield defense. She also serves as the Salukis' recruiting coordinator.

Prior to coaching, Connoyer played from 1990-94 as a shortstop and second baseman at Notre Dame.

## SALUKIS GO 11-1 IN FALL TOURNAMENTS

The Southern Illinois softball team posted a 11-1 record in its fall tournaments. The Salukis played in the Illinois State Fall Tournament, Kirkwood Fall Tournament and a rain-shortened Saluki Invitational.

SIU posted wins over Parkland College, SIU-Edwardsville (2), Illinois Central College, Western Illinois, Saint Louis, Southeast Missouri, Missouri-Rolla, McKendree College, John A. Logan College and Southern Indiana.

The lone loss came against MVC foe Illinois State. SIU out-scored its opponents 77-19 in the three tournaments.

Lauren Haas led the team in hitting with a .517 average (15-for-29). Haas, Becky Wegmann and

Jayne Wamsley each had three home runs in fall play.

Junior Cassidy Scoggins led the SIU pitching staff with a 1.11 ERA. She saw action in 34 innings with a 4-0 record, striking out 33 batters.

## SIU EARNS NFCA ACADEMIC TOP-10 HONOR FOR FIFTH STRAIGHT YEAR

For the fifth consecutive year, the Southern Illinois softball team finished in the top 10 in the nation in team grade point average.

SIU finished 10th with a 3.415 GPA, not far behind Detroit Mercy who finished first with a 3.591 GPA.

No stranger to the NFCA Academic Top 10, SIU finished fourth in 2001 (3.39 GPA), fourth in 2002 (3.39 GPA), sixth in 2003 (3.43 GPA) and fifth in 2004 (3.42 GPA).

During this time, the Dawgs also managed to finish in the top 25 in the final polls in three of the five years.

Amy Harre, Maria Damico, Katie Jordan, Cassidy Scoggins and Lauren Roney all contributed to the team's success as they received regional all-academic honors. Harre was named an academic all-american for the third-straight year.

## DAWGS RECEIVE VOTES IN PRESEASON TOP-25 POLLS

Following a record-setting 47-14 season in 2005, the Southern Illinois University softball team received votes in the ESPN.com/USA Softball and USA Today/NFCA Preseason Top 25 polls.

In the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll, the Salukis picked up 16 votes, coming in at what would be #29 in the nation. In the USA Today/NFCA poll, SIU came in at the would-be #32 position with 21 votes.

Defending national champion Michigan earned the top spot in both polls with 2005 NCAA Tournament runner-up UCLA coming in a close second in both.

Southern is the only Missouri Valley Conference team to receive votes in the USA Today/NFCA poll, with conference foe Wichita State picking up two votes in the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll.

## SALUKIS PICKED SECOND IN MVC PRESEASON COACHES' POLLS

The Southern Illinois University softball team was picked second in the Missouri Valley Conference preseason coaches' poll, released Tuesday morning.
