HALF-DAY CAMP

Boys and Girls, Ages 7-11
June 3-7, 2002

Our half-day camp is designed to instruct boys and girls in individual skills, tactics, and fundamentals of team play. Two sessions will be available for this age group:

MORNING SESSION: 9 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

EVENING SESSION: 6 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

Check-in time is on Monday, June 3, at 8:30 a.m. for the morning session and 5:30 p.m. for the evening sessions at R.P. Fuller soccer stadium located off Drive of Champions.

Each camper receives a camp ball, T-shirt and insurance while at camp.



LOCATION - FACILITIES

The Red Raider Soccer Camps will take place on the Texas Tech University campus. Campers use Red Raider Women's Soccer team facilities. All field sessions are held on grass. Residential campers will be housed in Weymouth hall on campus located at 18th and Flint. Campers are reminded to bring towels, pillow, two twin-sized flat sheets, blanket or sleeping bag, toiletries, and sunscreen. They will also need soccer shoes, shin guards, swimsuit, and enough training shirts, shorts and socks to make it through the week. Adult staff members and trainers are housed with the campers during the week to ensure 24-hour supervision.



A MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR

Our camp provides a unique soccer learning environment for young players. Our daily training schedule includes individual, small group and team instruction in technique and tactics. Small-sided evening games allow residential campers to apply what they learn during the day. At our camp you will receive top-level coaching from national and state licensed instructors. Due to the popularity of the half day camp, enrollment is limited to ensure a quality camp experience for each player. Campers will be accepted on a first come first serve basis.



GIRLS RESIDENTIAL CAMP

Ages: 12-18
June 16-20, 2002

Our girls' residential curriculum is demanding and thorough-for the serious player. This session is designed to develop the players technical and tactical abilities through functional game-related training. For the college bound high school athlete, our College Recruiting Night program will offer insight into the college recruiting process. Commuters are welcome at our residential camp. Residential campers will receive a camp ball, T-shirt, written player evaluation, and insurance while at camp.

Check-in time is on Sunday, June 16 between 3:30 - 4:30 pm at Weymouth Hall located on campus at 18th and Flint.
