#### The Match

Texas Tech (11-7-1/4-5-1) is the seventh seed in the Big 12 Championship and faces second seed and 10th-ranked Oklahoma State (15-3-1/8-2) in the quarterfinals on Wed., Nov. 3, at 8 p.m. at Blossom Soccer Stadium in San Antonio, Texas.

#### On the Web

Live stats and free live video will be available at both TexasTech.com and Big12Sports.com. Live video action from the quarterfinals and the semifinals will be streamed by Big12Sports.com. Bobby Rhine, former MLS player, will call the action for the second-straight year.

#### The Red Raiders

Texas Tech is making its fourth-straight appearance and sixth overall in the Big 12 Championship. The Red Raiders own an 11-7-1 overall record and finished in a tie for seventh place in the Big 12 with a 4-5-1 mark after being shutout at Baylor, 2-0, last Friday in Waco. On the year, freshman Jessica Fuston leads the team in points with 22, goals with 10, shots with 50 and shots-on-goal with 30. Freshman Jessica Disabella has a team-high six assists. Junior Taylor Lytle is second on the team in points with 13 as she has five assists and four goals. Fuston has a team-best four game-winning goals. Junior Casey McCall leads the team in minutes played with 1,731. Senior Colleen Pitts and sophomore Erin Wikelius have both seen time in the nets with Wikelius playing 881:24 minutes with 37 saves and allowing 13 goals for a 1.33 goals-against average. She is 5-3-1 with four shutouts. Pitts has played 856:50 minutes with 45 saves, while allowing 10 goals for a 1.05 goals-against average. Pitts is 6-4 with six shutouts.

#### The Opponent

No. 10 Oklahoma State enters the championship with a 15-3-1 overall record and finished second in the conference with an 8-2

record after shutting out Oklahoma, 2-0, last Friday in Norman. On the year, junior Krista Lopez has team highs of 26 points, 12 goals, 55 shots and 28 shots-on-goal. Six of Lopez's goals have been game winners, a team best. Senior Katie Richardson and junior Kyndall Treadwell lead the Cowgirls in assists with four apiece. Sophomore Adrianna French has played 1681:77 minutes in the nets with a 15-3-1 record. She has registered eight shutouts and has compiled 68 saves, while allowing 11 goals with a 0.59 goals-against average. Head coach Colin Carmichael is in his fifth season at the helm of the Cowgirls with a career record of 89-26-16.

#### Last Time vs. OSU

The Texas Tech soccer team suffered its first conference loss Sunday afternoon as 12th-ranked Oklahoma State defeated the Red Raiders, 2-0, at the Cowgirl Soccer Complex. Tech was without All-Big 12 first teamer junior Taylor Lytle for the fourth-straight game as she could only play eight minutes due to an injury she suffered against North Texas



Freshman Jessica Fuston was named the Big 12 Rookie of the Year, All-Big 12 second team and to the Big 12 All-Newcomer team.

on Sept. 12. Texas Tech was pinned into its own end by an aggressive OSU team and a 25 mph wind running straight down the field. OSU got the early goal when the left winger served a ball across the Red Raider box. With senior goalkeeper Colleen Pitts having a play on the ball and right back junior Madison Terry cutting off her player on the back post, it was a routine play that went wrong when neither player cleared the ball leaving OSU leading scorer, junior Krista Lopez, wide open to tap the ball in for the first goal of the game in the fifth minute of play. Tech was outshot for the half but spirits were high at halftime about equalizing the game in the second half. With Tech playing four forwards, including junior Casey McCall, the Cowgirls secured the win with under eight minutes to go on a counter attack whereby Lopez connected for her second goal left-footed after getting around the Tech backline and firing a shot to the far post. Tech's best chances to score were from sophomore Dawn Ward, who got around the OSU backline and sent a shot wide, and sophomore Tiffini Smith's blast from second distance, which forced OSU's keeper to tip it over for a Tech corner kick. Pitts returned to the nets playing all 90 minutes with eight saves. Pitts now has a 5-2 record in goal on the year.

### Series Record

The Cowgirls hold a 10-4-1 advantage over

Texas Tech as they have won the last four games, including a match in the Big 12 Championship in 2008. Back in September, OSU shutout the Red Raiders, 2-0, in Stillwater. Last year, OSU won 2-1 in Lubbock on Oct. 16, in front of a Tech school record 1,728 fans. The last time the Red Raiders won was in head coach Tom Stone's first season, 1-0, on Oct. 21, 2007, in Lubbock. This is the second time the two are meeting in the Big 12 Championship. OSU defeated Tech, 3-0, in the quarterfinals of the championship on Nov. 5, 2008.

### Tech in the Big 12 Championship

Texas Tech is making its fourth-straight appearance in the Big 12 Championship and its sixth overall appearance. The Red Raiders are looking for their first win in the championship as they hold a 0-5 record in the tournament. Tech's first appearance was in 1996 and then again in 1999 before taking a seven-year hiatus. Then head coach Tom Stone took over the helm in 2007 and the Red Raiders have been back to the championship each year. In last year's championship, the Red Raiders lost to Kansas in penalty kicks in a play-in game. After Kansas swept through its five attempts and Tech connected on its first four, KU goalkeeper Kat Liebetrau stopped a Maggie Fete penalty kick to push the Jayhawks into the Big 12 Championship after a 1-1 tie through regulation and two overtime periods.

**34-33-8, Fourth Year**

In just his fourth year, Tom Stone has spearheaded Texas Tech's resurgence in the Big 12 as he led the Red Raiders to the conference tournament in all three seasons after a seven-year drought that dated back to 1999. The Tech soccer program had not previously qualified for the Big 12 Championship in three-consecutive seasons in school history.

Stone's third season brought the most successful season at Tech in the last 10 years. With a full recruiting class on campus that regularly fielded around seven freshmen in the starting lineup, the Red Raiders finished the 2009 campaign 8-8-4, marking the first time since 1996 that a Tech team had a .500 or better overall record. The Red Raiders made their third-straight appearance in the Big 12 Championship.

Tech's rise was recognized like never before, however, as four players were honored to an All-Big 12 postseason team in 2009, led by Taylor Lytle, who became only the school's second player all-time to be named to the first team after a strong sophomore campaign where she broke the school's single-game and single-season assist records. Freshmen Dawn Ward, Tiffini Smith and Morgan Johnson were also named to the all-newcomer team, which gave Tech more freshmen honored than any other Big 12 program.

Prior to his arrival at Tech, Stone spent one season helping lead Clemson as an assistant coach to the NCAA Final Eight where the Tigers eventually ended their season 11-8-5 overall, which was the best season in Clemson school history.

Before beginning his career on the collegiate level, some of Stone's greatest accomplishments may have come from his time leading the Atlanta Beat of the Women's United Soccer Association during all three years of its existence.

When the WUSA ceased operations in 2003, Stone was named the technical director of the Top Hat Soccer Club in Atlanta, which is one of the top girls youth programs in the southern region. While with Top Hat, Stone was primarily involved in all areas of club and player development and the College Prep Program that prepares top players for college soccer opportunities. He was also the head coach for the 2007 Gold Team that won the Georgia State Championship in 2004 and the Southern Regional Premier League in 2005, while also serving as the head coach of the Gwinnett Country club team that won the regional championship and qualified for the national championship match in 2005.

Before beginning his professional career, Stone was the founding director of coaching at the Colorado Rush Soccer Club from 1991 to 2000. Under Stone's direction, the Rush would go on to win 35 state cups along with 12 regional championships and seven national championships, becoming arguably the most successful youth girls program in the U.S. from 1997 to 2000.

Stone has also served as a volunteer assistant coach at Duke in 1997 and the University of Denver in 1996.

### Big 12 Honors

Texas Tech had two players receive Big 12 postseason honors as freshman Jessica Fuston was named the Big 12 Rookie of the Year, All-Big 12 second team and to the Big 12 All-Newcomer team. Fuston is the first Red Raider to win one of the conference's top awards (Offensive Player of Year, Defensive Player of the Year and Rookie of the Year). Junior Whitney Sharpe was also named All-Big 12 second team and to the Big 12 All-Newcomer team.

### RPI

In the latest NCAA RPI released this week, Texas Tech is ranked 52nd among all 322 Division I schools.

### NCAA Stats

As of games through Oct. 31, freshman Jessica Fuston ranks 67th in goals per game at .526, among all Division I players. As a team, Texas Tech ranks 21st in shutout percentage at .526, among all Division I teams.

### School Record for Shutouts

Texas Tech has recorded 10 shutouts this year which is a school record for most shutouts in a season. The previous record was eight in 1994 and 1995.

### First Winning Season Since 1996

The win over Kansas guaranteed the Red Raiders their first winning season since 1996 when they finished 13-8. Tech stands 11-6-1 with one regular-season game remaining.

### Fuston Named Big 12 Newcomer of the Week Again After Recording Hat Trick

For the second-straight week and the third time this season, freshman Jessica Fuston was named the Big 12 Newcomer of the Week after recording her first hat trick as she scored all three goals in the 3-2 overtime win over Iowa State. Only seven minutes into the game, junior Taylor Lytle turned her player and slipped Fuston in behind the ISU backline for a breakthrough. Fuston, who had an historic night for the Red Raiders, slotted the keeper to her shooter's left and Tech had the lead 1-0. In the 50th minute, sophomore Sarah Ellison got down the flank, beat her defender and served a low serve across the face of the goal. Fuston was in position again on the serve just inside her defender and headed it home to push Tech ahead, 2-1. In overtime (96th minute) senior Leanne Mihelich toe-poked the ball on goal with some pace. The bullet shot rebounded off the Iowa State goalkeeper and fell again to Mihelich who slipped the ball over to Fuston who capped her fabulous outing with the game winner in overtime. The goals were her eighth, ninth and 10th of the year – a team best.

### Another Assist for Lytle

Junior Taylor Lytle got her fifth assist of the year and the 24th of her career which put her just two away from tying the school record for career assists. Kristy Frantz (1996-99) holds the school record with 26.

### **Disabella Picks Up Two Assists vs. Mizzou**

Freshman Jessica Disabella picked up two assists against Missouri to give her a team-best six assists on the year.

### **Third Goal for McCall**

For the second time in three games and the third time this season, junior defender Casey McCall scored another goal for the Red Raiders. In her previous two years, McCall had scored just one goal each season but this year she has had her first multi-goal season. McCall scored her first goal of the year against Colorado and then had one against Kansas and Missouri.

### **Big 12 Newcomer of the Week, Again**

Freshman Jessica Fuston received her second Big 12 Newcomer of the Week honor on Oct. 19, as she scored her team-leading seventh goal of the season when she headed in a corner kick from junior Taylor Lytle for the game-winning goal against Kansas. It was her third game-winning game of the year, which is tied with Lytle to lead the team.

### **Lytle Returns to Lineup**

Junior Taylor Lytle returned to the lineup for the first time in eight games. After suffering an ankle injury on Sept. 10 vs. North Texas, Lytle missed the Oral Roberts match and then played sparingly the next seven games. She collected two assists in the game against Kansas.

### **Wikelius Notches Fourth Shutout**

Entering the season, sophomore goalkeeper Erin Wikelius had not recorded a shutout in her career, but now has notched four this year alone. The four stand tied for seventh on Tech's single season list for shutouts.

### **McCall's Minutes**

Junior Casey McCall has played all but seven minutes in Tech's 1,731 minutes this season. The junior defender is one of three players to start all 18 matches this year.

### **Fuston Tallies Five Points Against Huskers**

Freshman Jessica Fuston collected five points in the overtime loss to Nebraska as she netted two goals and picked up an assist. It was the third time this season for a multi-goal game as she scored twice versus TCU in the season opener and twice at Rice.

### **Yacullo Named a CS360 Primetime Performer**

Freshman Mallory Yacullo scored her first collegiate goal in exciting fashion and was named a CollegeSoccer360.com Primetime Performer for it. Trailing 4-2 against Nebraska, freshman Jessica Fuston scored on

a penalty kick with under two and half minutes to go to put the score 4-3. With under 10 seconds to go, junior Madison Terry served a driven ball to the back post and junior Casey McCall challenged hard for the cross and got enough on it to get to the far post where Yacullo came flying in to hammer home the tying goal just as the clock hit zero, sending the game into overtime.

### **McCall Scores First Goal**

Junior Casey McCall scored her first goal of the season and the third of her career in the win over Colorado. In the sixth minute of play, McCall hammered one in from six yards out with her head on a corner kick from freshman Jessica Disabella. It was McCall's first career game-winning goal. It was also Disabella's fourth assist of the year.

### **Another Shutout for Pitts**

Senior Colleen Pitts picked up her sixth shutout of the season in the 1-0 win over Colorado. Pitts played all 90 minutes in the nets and registered five saves. The six shutouts ranks second on Texas Tech's single season list. Standing in first is Tina Rincon with eight. Pitts now has nine shutouts in her career, which is fourth best all-time at Tech.

### **Season-High Attendance**

Texas Tech soccer has become a big hit around the Lubbock community, especially in the last couple of years, and it was evident again this year. Tech had a season-high 1,643 fans at the match against Colorado. The Red Raiders averaged 1,192 fans per game this season.

### **Ward Scores Fourth Goal**

Sophomore Dawn Ward got her fourth goal of the season as she scored the first of three goals for the Red Raiders in the win at Oklahoma. The goal gives her 17 in her career and she needs just one more goal to move into a tie for fifth on Tech's career goals list.

### **First Career Assist for Fuston**

After scoring four goals this season, freshman Jessica Fuston got her first career assist on sophomore Dawn Ward's goal at Oklahoma in the Big 12 season opener.

### **Big Game for Smith at OU**

Sophomore Tiffini Smith had a big game in the victory at Oklahoma as she collected three points on the night. Smith was credited with the assist in freshman Jessica Disabella's goal in the 23rd minute and then scored her first goal of the season in the 61st minute to secure the win for the Red Raiders.

### **A Season of Firsts**

After starting the season off 5-0, the Red Raiders have already made their marks in the record books. The 5-0 start is the best in school history against Division I opponents and to go along with those five wins have been five shutouts. The five shutouts is the first time in the program's history that a Tech team began the season with five-consecutive shutouts.

### **All-Tournament Team, Again**

Texas Tech had six players honored for their play during the Red Raider Classic Sept. 10 and 12. Sophomore Haley Fowler was named the Defensive MVP, while sophomore Erin Wikelius took home Goalkeeper MVP honors. Four other Red Raiders were named to the all-tournament team – junior Taylor Lytle, sophomores Sarah Ellison and Tiffini Smith and freshman Jessica Disabella. It was Lytle's second all-tournament team selection this season.

### **Disabella Scores First Collegiate Goal**

It took almost 85 minutes to get the game-winning goal, but that's exactly what freshman Jessica Disabella did against North Texas. It marked the first collegiate goal for the Flower Mound, Texas, native. She followed it up in the next game with an assist on the game-winning goal against Oral Roberts. It was her third assist on the year.

### **Ellison Notches Third Goal**

Sophomore Sarah Ellison notched her third goal of the season and her first career game-winning goal against Oral Roberts, which came in the 56th minute of the match.

### **Disabella Named Big 12 Newcomer of the Week**

Freshman Jessica Disabella was named the Big 12 Newcomer of the week for her performances against North Texas and Oral Roberts. Disabella totaled three points on the weekend as the Red Raiders improved to 7-1 and notched their sixth and seventh shutouts of the season. The midfielder secured her first collegiate goal on Friday, the game-winner in the 84th minutes as Tech edged North Texas, 1-0. On Sunday, she provided the assist for the game-winning goal as the Red Raiders defeated Oral Roberts, 1-0.

### **All-Tournament Team**

Three Red Raiders graced the All-Tournament team at the Inn at Saint Mary's Classic hosted by Notre Dame. Junior Taylor Lytle, sophomore Dawn Ward and freshman Hayley Haagsma were all honored for their stellar performances that weekend.

### **Moving on Up**

Junior Taylor Lytle continues to move up the charts on Tech's career lists. Lytle jumped to second on Tech's career shots list with 184. Her 50 career points is fifth all-time. She is just two assists shy of tying the school record for career assists. Her game-winning goal against Ole Miss gives her five in her career, which ranks tied for fourth all-time. That goal also gave her 13 career goals, moving her to 10th (tied) on the career goals list. ### **Receiving Votes for the First Time**

Another first in the history of the program took place the week of Aug. 30, as Tech received votes in the NSCAA/HendrickCars.com National Rankings (top 25 poll). Tech got 14 votes in the poll which is voted on by a panel of Division I college coaches. Tech also received votes on Sept. 7 and Sept. 14.

### **Big 12 Newcomer of the Week**

Freshman Jessica Fuston was named the Big 12 Newcomer of the week for her performances at Northwestern State and Rice. Fuston started both of Texas Tech's matches last weekend and played all 90 minutes at Rice. The freshman forward scored her third and fourth goals of the season on Sunday against the Owls and is tied for third in the conference with eight total points.

### **First Half Goals Tied for Second**

Freshman Jessica Fuston's two first-half goals against TCU and Rice are tied for second on the single-game list for first half goals. The record for most goals in the first half is three set by Chessa Purser against Prairie View A&M in 2006 and Brittney Harrison versus Northwestern State in 2008.

### **Fuston Earns Honors**

Freshman forward Jessica Fuston made her collegiate debut Aug. 20 and 22, and her standout efforts did not go unnoticed. The Cedar Park, Texas, native garnered TopDrawerSoccer.com Team of the Week honors. Fuston was the only Big 12 player named to that week's team.

### **Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week**

Senior goalkeeper Colleen Pitts received her first Big 12 honor as she was named the Big 12 Defensive Player of the Week on Aug. 24, for her performances against TCU and Texas State. Pitts recorded two shutouts as she played all 90 minutes in both matches and tallied 10 saves on the weekend.

### **Lytle, McCall Named Captains**

Tom Stone has called upon two juniors to lead this team as Taylor Lytle and Casey McCall have been named team captains for the 2010 season.

### **Lytle Preseason All-Big 12**

After a stellar sophomore campaign, junior Taylor Lytle looks to continue on her success into 2010 as she was named preseason All-Big 12. Last season, Lytle became only the school's second player all-time to be named first team All-Big 12, while breaking the school's single-game and single-season assist records.
