LAST TIME OUT

The Green Wave got past Penn State, 63-60, in a hard fought battle on Friday afternoon in the second round of the Charleston Classic. The game saw 13 lead changes and 11 ties before Tulane took a five-point lead late in the game on a **Kevin Sims** 3-pointer. Sims finished the game with 11 points and three assists, while **Aaron Holmes** led the way with 17 points and **Kris Richard** added 14 points and six rebounds. **David Booker** had six points, eight rebounds and three blocks in his first start of the season.

ABOUT LASALLE

The Explorers, out of the Atlantic 10 Conference, are 2-1 this season with victories over Hampton and Davidson. The loss came to South Carolina in the first round of the Charleston Classic. **Dr. John Giannini**, in his sixth season as head coach, leads LaSalle. He owns a 73-80 record at LaSalle and a 370-229 career record in his 21st season.

THE CHARLESTON CLASSIC

Tulane travels to Charleston, S.C., for the Charleston Classic and lost to Miami (Fla.) in the opening game on Thursday. The Green Wave defeated Penn State in the second round on Friday and will take on LaSalle in the final round on Sunday. The Tournament takes place in Carolina First Arena and will continue on Sunday. In addition to the Green Wave and Miami, UNC Wilmington, Penn State, South Florida, Davidson, LaSalle and South Carolina.

CLOSE TO THE CENTURY MARK

The 2009-10 campaign marks the 99th season for the Tulane basketball program.

SIMS HONORED IN PRESEASON

Senior guard **Kevin Sims** has been named as a pre-season Second-team All-Conference USA selection USA Today Sports Weekly and third-team by Lindy's College Basketball. Sims led Tulane last season with 13.0 points per game, 4.0 assists per game and 51 3-pointers made.

SIMS ON COUSY AWARD WATCH LIST

For the second straight year, Tulane's guard **Kevin Sims**, is one of 34 players from around the nation to be named to the Bob Cousy Award Watch List. The Cousy Award is given annually to the nation's top point guard.

DICKERSON IN FOGELMAN

Tulane has a record of 37-19 (.662) at Fogelman Arena and a mark of 22-9 (.710) against non-conference teams in New Orleans under **Dave Dickerson**.

FOGELMAN MAGIC

Tulane has won a combined 31 games on its home floor the last three seasons, including 10+ win campaigns in all three years. The Wave reached the 10-win plateau for the third straight season and finished with a 10-5 mark a year ago and was 11-4 at home in 2006-07 and 10-6 in 2007-08.

DICKERSON ENTERS 5TH CAMPAIGN

Tulane head coach **Dave Dickerson** is in his fifth season at the helm of the Green Wave basketball program and has an overall record of 61-63. One constant for Tulane during Dickerson's tenure has been its success in opening round games of the Conference USA Tournament. Last season, the Green Wave moved to 4-0 under Dickerson when it downed East Carolina, 69-59, in the first round of the 2009 Conference USA Men's Basketball Tournament.

TIMMONS RETURNS

The Green Wave will regain the services of **Kendall Timmons** after the first year player was lost for the majority of the 2008-09 season with a back injury. Prior to being sidelined, Timmons averaged 5.4 points per contest, but was coming on strong after posting a career-best 18 points on the road at George Mason. He played injured in the next game against Binghamton and did not return.

BOOKER HAS CAREER NIGHT

Junior forward **David Booker** had himself a career night in the season opener against Georgetown in Nov. 13. The Moss Point, Miss., native scored 14 points, grabbed nine rebounds, hit two 3-pointers, has three steals, played 29 minutes and blocked one shot, all career-highs. Booker connected on 6 of 8 from the field, including a pair of 3-pointers.

THE NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

Tulane bolstered each position on the team with the addition of its four newcomers, including freshman **Jordan Callahan** at point guard, junior-transfer **Aaron Holmes** at guard/forward, freshman **Terrance Beasley**, freshman **Kelth Cameron** at forward/center. Callahan (5-11, 170) averaged 14.3 points and 4.8 assists per game and set the school's single-season scoring mark with 443 points during his final season at Roswell's (Ga.) Blessed Trinity High School. Holmes (6-5, 195) is a shooting guard from St. Petersburg, Fla., who was rated as a top 50 national prospect as a senior after scoring 2,748 career points as a prepster at St. Petersburg Catholic High School. He spent last season at Santa Fe Community College where he averaged 21 points and shot nearly 50 percent from the field in 19 games. A native of Pensacola, Fla., Beasley (6-

6, 210) ranked as the No. 48 small forward by ESPN.com and averaged 17 points and nine rebounds per game as a senior. Cameron (6-8, 255) is a native of New Orleans and a graduate of East St. John High School. As a senior, he averaged 12.3 points, 10.5 rebounds and 6.0 blocked shots.

SIMS DISHES THE ROCK

Kevin Sims produced 123 assists a year ago and became just the third player in school history to lead Tulane in assists over the course of three straight seasons. The only other two players to accomplish the feat were Joe Holston (1978-81) and Pointer Williams (1991-94).

MILESTONE FOR SIMS
