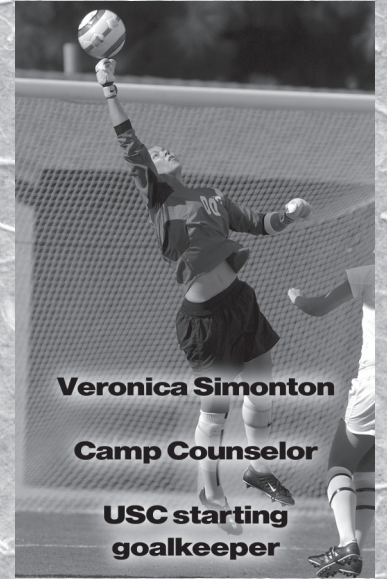
In 10 years with Jim Millinder as head coach, USC women's soccer highlights include:

I will be directing the camp along with my staff and players. There will also be guest appearances from other top college coaches and players. You will train and play daily on the USC campus at McAlister Field, the home field of the USC women's soccer program.

Jim Millinder USC Head Coach

After becoming the head coach at USC 10 years ago, Jim Millinder has built the program into a Top 25 contender. He has guided the Women of Troy to the NCAA Tournament seven times (1998-2003, 2005). In 1998, USC won the Pac-10 for the first time and earned its first-ever NCAA Tournament bid. Millinder was named Pac-10 Coach of the Year in 1996 and 1998. The 1997 squad went a school-record 16-3-1 and had a final national ranking of No. 21 in Soccer Buzz. Millinder was named 1997 West Region Coach of the Year by both the NSCAA/Umbro and Soccer Buzz for his team's efforts.

He played professional soccer for eight years in the North American Soccer League, the American Soccer League and the Major Indoor Soccer League.

Millinder was a member of the U.S. World Cup team in 1982, the U.S. Olympic team in 1978 and 1979, and the U.S. Junior National (Under-21) team in 1976.



Live-in Camp at USC

Date: July 16-20 (Ages 9-13)
July 23-27 (Ages 14-18)
Fees: Resident: \$535; Day: \$435

Daily Schedule: Two-hour training sessions will be conducted in both the morning and afternoon. In the early evening, matches will be played amongst the campers and counselors. Later in the evening, films, strategy classes and motivational talks will be given.

Training: Each day, the coaches focus on a theme that progresses from individual, group and team functions throughout the two training sessions and culminates with the evening game.

Goalkeepers: Goalkeepers train separately in the morning session before being incorporated into their group's activities in the afternoon and evening.

Included in the Camp: Participants will receive a camp ball, t-shirt and instruction from top coaches. Contests will be held with prizes awarded. Guest appearances by professional and international players will be made.

Housing and Meals: Resident campers are housed two per room at Trojan Hall on the USC campus with 24-hour supervision by experienced live-in staff. Our staff is selected for their experience in coaching and handling children. All-you-can eat meals are served in the on-campus dining hall. Day campers are served lunch and dinner.

Late Arrival: We understand some campers may be involved in tournament play with their clubs on the Sunday check-in date. Once your tournament has finished, you may arrive at USC, check in and join the camp immediately.

Nat Gonzalez USC Associate Head Coach

Nat Gonzalez begins his third season as associate head coach after spending three seasons (2001-03) as the head men's coach at UC Riverside. His main responsibilities include recruiting and coaching the goalkeepers.

Prior to UC Riverside, Gonzalez served as goalkeeping coach and first assistant for the men's team at Washington (1996-2000) with the team posting a 61-15-5 record during his tenure.

He was a four-year letterwinner and goalkeeper at UCLA (1988-91) and member of the 1990 Bruins' national championship team.

Gonzalez played six seasons professionally in the Major Indoor Soccer League and currently holds a USSF "B" license.



Local Check-in/Check-out (for campers who will not fly in): Check-in for Camp #1 on Sunday (July 16) and Camp #2 on Sunday (July 23) will be from 1 p.m. to 2 p.m. at Trojan Hall. Check-in information will be sent out upon receiving registration. Check-out for Camp #1 on Thursday (July 20) and Camp #2 on Thursday (July 27) will be from 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Team Discounts: Fees for teams that have 10 or more players enrolling together are \$450 each (an \$85 discount per player). All applications must be received in the same envelope. Teams can stay intact and practice and play together.

Transportation: Round-trip ground transportation from Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) airport to USC will be offered for \$25. Arrangements must be made prior to your arrival. All campers who require ground transportation should schedule their flights to arrive at LAX between 10 a.m. and 1 p.m. on the day of camp checkin. Departures from LAX should be the day of checkout.

Application Process: Applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis. Send the application in early because last year's camp sold out! Upon receipt of application and fees, a confirmation will be sent out regarding registration procedures. **The balance of camp fees must be postmarked by June 1, 2006** or your space will be given away. Roommate requests received after June 1, 2006 will not be guaranteed. These dates apply to all camps. Fees are \$535/Resident, \$435/Day. Non-refundable \$150 deposit per session must accompany application. Applications received after June 1 must be submitted with all fees and will be accepted on a space-available basis. Credit cards can be used at uscrojans.com.

Cancellation Policy: If you cancel prior to the dates of either camp, you may receive full credit to a future USC soccer camp or a refund of the camp registration minus the \$150 non-refundable deposit. Cancellations on or after the start date of camp will not be refunded.

Isabelle Harvey USC Assistant Coach

Four-time All-American Isabelle Harvey begins her second season with the USC coaching staff.

She spent four seasons (2001-04) as an assistant coach at Cal State Los Angeles for the men's and women's soccer programs following the close of her USC playing career and served as the interim head coach for the men's and women's team during the 2002-03 season.

Harvey, a native of Cap-Rouge, Quebec, Canada, still holds school career records for goals (48), assists (39), game-winning goals (21) and points (135).

As a member of the Canadian National Team at the 1999 Women's World Cup, Harvey started all three games for Canada and registered two assists.
