

APPENDIX K

Criteria for Hosting the MWC Outdoor Track and Field Championships

1. According to MWC rules, the Championships will be conducted under NCAA track and field rules.
2. The order of events will be conducted per the rule book.
3. The facility must accommodate:
 - a. LJ, TJ & PV runways which take advantage of the wind and have the ability to be reversed in direction of run.
 - b. The 100m, 110m, 100m straightaway must be able to accommodate the ability to run either way to take advantage of the wind.
 - c. The 200m must be able to be run around either turn.
 - d. The above indicates that Timing systems are available for accommodating these events, meaning multiple cameras.
4. Where wind is a factor in throwing events the facility must be able to accommodate the best conditions to maximize efforts. (wind, where it applies.)
5. Where heat, or environmental conditions are extreme and the conducting of the events demands a revised schedule, lighting must be in place in order to conduct the events as listed in the rule book. (Where daylight hour permit the timely completion of the meet in daylight, the events can be run later in the day, in order to avoid these extremes.)
6. Host institution will propose a tentative schedule. Starting times and schedule of events will be in accordance with the NCAA rule book and order of events. The time schedule will be approved by games committee.
7. Have the resources to provide the officials to cover the meet in all of its requirements:
 - a. Event specific, namely field events
 - b. Running
 - c. Photo finish
 - d. That the head official for each event is certified.
8. Must have the ability to show the numbered marking of all field events:
 - a. Distance markers for all field events.
 - b. Result indicators for each event.
 - c. For running: wind indicators and running events results for immediate posting to a Scoreboard.
