



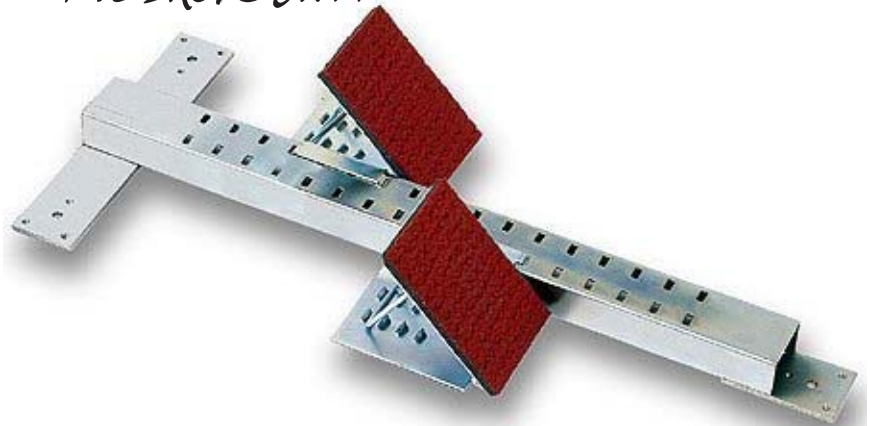

2005 MEN'S CHAMPIONSHIPS RECAP

54th Annual Men's Outdoor Track & Field

May 26-28, 2005

Cardinal Park - Louisville, Kentucky

Dickinson State University (N.D.) defended its men's national title with a convincing point total of 99, besting runner-up Virginia Intermont by 16 points. Dickinson State won five individual titles on its way to victory. The Blue Hawks got stellar performances out of Derrick Atkins, who repeated as three-time champion in the 100-meter dash and also won 200-meter title, and Aaron Cleare with his defended of the 400-meter dash.

Virginia Intermont College finished second with a final score of 83. Oklahoma Baptist University's Pat Brown was named the men's Most Outstanding Performer for his record-breaking performance in the 400-meter hurdles. Brown ran a time of 49.51 seconds, breaking a 21-year old record by .56 of a second.

Pete Stanton of Dickinson State was named the men's Coach of the Year
