2005 MEN'S GOLF CHAMPIONSHIPS RECAP

54th Annual NAIA Men's Golf National Championships
 May 24-27, 2005 - Prairie Highlands Golf Course - Olathe, Kansas

Last year's runner-up Johnson & Wales University (Fla.) posted a 19-under par four-day total of 1133 to claim the 2005 NAIA Men's Golf National Championship at Prairie Highlands Golf Course. Wildcat team member James Renner carded a seven-under par 281 to capture individual medalist honors. Johnson & Wales University (Fla.) carded its highest round of the tournament at four-over par 292 for the final round, but had posted early rounds of 281, 282 and 278 to separate itself from the rest of the pack. Runner-up Oklahoma Christian University finished at nine-over par 1161 for the tournament.

The individual medalist competition came down to the final day as Brent Akins of Oklahoma City and Kenny Adams of California State University-San Marcos were tied heading into the final round. Both shot scores of 66 in earlier rounds, but Akins carded a one-over par 73 while Adams recorded a three-over par 75 in the final round to allow Renner the chance for victory. Renner shot a one-under par 71 for the final round for a four-round total of 281 and the individual championship as he finished at seven-under par for the tournament, one stroke better than Akins. Point Loma Nazarene University's (Calif.) Chris Hudson finished the round with a tournament-low 65, just one stroke off the NAIA record.

Juan Marquine of Spring Hill College (Ala.) carded an ace on No. 8 during the opening round.

The 72-hole event was cut to the top 17 teams and 40 individuals after the completion of 54 holes. The top 15 finishers plus ties were named to the all-tournament team. For the victory, Johnson & Wales head coach David Adamonis was named the NAIA Men's Golf Coach of the Year.
