2007 MEN'S GOLF RECAP

OKLAHOMA CITY WINS SIXTH TITLE

Top-ranked Oklahoma City University turned in a stunning nine-under par final round 279 to repeat as champions at the 2007 NAIA Men's Golf National Tournament at Indiana National Golf Club. The crown was their sixth in the past seven years. The Stars' Daniel Mitchell was the tournament medalist, firing a five under 67 for a 282 (-6) total.

Oklahoma City owned an eight shot advantage to begin the day and had just gone off the first tee when play was interrupted for two hours due to heavy rain. The delay did nothing to dampen the red-hot Stars upon the resumption of play as they only increased their lead throughout the afternoon. Wayland Baptist University (Texas) shot 289 (+1) to finish 18 strokes behind. Oklahoma Christian University finished in third while Johnson & Wales University (Fla.) and Berry College (Ga.) rounded out the top five.

Mitchell, was the first round leader and never fell out of the top three during the tournament. Third round leader, Sam Cyr from Point Loma Nazarene University (Calif.) shot a 74 on the day and finished as the tournament runner-up at 285 (-3). Mitchell's teammate Jacques Blaauw finished at even par 288 to tie with Jeff Dagg from Wayland Baptist in third place with Oklahoma Christian's Bruno Buccolo a further shot back.

2007 WOMEN'S GOLF RECAP

OKLAHOMA CITY WINS THIRD STRAIGHT TITLE

Two-time defending champion Oklahoma City held off a furious charge over the final three rounds from Lindsey Wilson (Ky.) to claim its unprecedented third straight national title winning the 2007 NAIA Women's Golf National Championship Friday afternoon.

The Stars, who sat atop the leader board from start to finish, posted a 72-hole score of 1237, finishing 18 strokes ahead of the Blue Raiders (1255). The margin of victory is the slimmest since British Columbia defeated Oklahoma City by 5 strokes (1249-1254) at the LPGA International in Daytona Beach, Fla., in 2004. Last year, OCU won by 34 (1215-1249) and then won by 49 strokes (1226-1275) in 2005.

Lindsey Wilson sat in tenth place after a 325 in the opening round but began a steady climb up the leader board from there. LWC trailed by 12 strokes entering the day and trimmed the deficit to ten at the turn, but OCU, which returned four players from last year's national title team, played the challenging back nine at ten-over to hold off the charge.

Freshman Krista Burton of Lindsey Wilson shot a two-over 74 today to win the individual title with a 4-round total of 295 (74-74-73-74), snapping a string of two straight individual titles won by Oklahoma City.
