2005 NAIA Indoor Track & Field National Championships

Oklahoma Baptist Takes Women's Title, Lindenwood Wins Men's Championship

Johnson City, Tennessee – Oklahoma Baptist University captured the women's team title while Lindenwood University (Mo.) won the men's team title at the 2005 SunTrust-NAIA Men's and Women's Indoor Track National Championships. The titles ended the championship streaks of Azusa Pacific University (Calif.), which had won the last three men's team titles and the last two women's championships.

In the women's standings, Oklahoma Baptist tallied 86.50 points to win the title as McKendree College (Ill.) finished in the runner-up spot with 72 points. Simon Fraser University (B.C.) finished third with 65 points while Azusa Pacific University placed fourth with 55 points.

In the men's standings, Lindenwood racked up 100.25 points to capture the title as Virginia Intermont College finished second with 82 points. Oklahoma Baptist finished third with 53 points while Azusa Pacific University came in fourth with 41 points.

In the women's 5000 meters, Mirian Kaumba, a junior from Oklahoma Baptist, posted a time of 16:20.97 to capture the title as she shattered the previous record of 17:18.17 by Sarah Korir of McKendree College (Ill.) in 2000. In addition, Petrana Petkova, a sophomore from Goshen College (Ind.), finished second in a time of 17:23.49 which is believed to be a new Bulgarian national indoor record. In the women's distance medley relay, Simon Fraser also took the title in record fashion with a time of 11:43.08, edging their own previous record of 11:45.09 from 1998.

Other women's records broken during the championships included Vivian Chukwuemeka, a senior from Azusa Pacific, who captured her fourth consecutive title in the weight throw with a record toss of 18.80 meters. Jen Sturzynski, a senior from Roberts Wesleyan College (N.Y.), broke the record in the pole vault with a leap of 4.00 meters.

Kendrick Triggs, of Lindenwood, earned the Men's Outstanding Performer award as he finished first in both the 55 meters and 200 meters and was a member of Lindenwood's winning 4x400-meter relay team.

Two athletes, Rosemary Okafor of McKendree and Julia Howard of Simon Fraser, shared the Women's Outstanding Performer honor. Okafor finished first in the 400 meters, second in the 200 meters, third in the 55 meters and was a member of McKendree's second-place 4x400-meter relay team. Howard took first in the one-mile event and the 1000 meters and was also a member of Simon Fraser's winning distance medley relay team.

Lane Lohr of Lindenwood was named the Men's National Coach of the Year and Ford Mastin of Oklahoma Baptist was named the Women's National Coach of the Year.
