## 2005 NAIA WRESTLING NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

### LINDENWOOD CAPTURES NATIONAL TITLE

**SIoux CITY, Iowa** – Lindenwood University (Mo.) won its second wrestling national title with 178.5 points, 50 points ahead of Missouri Valley College. The Lions won the 2002 title with 180 points, the most points ever scored in a championship. The 48<sup>th</sup> Annual NAIA Wrestling National Championships was contested in the Tyson Events Center/Gateway Arena in Sioux City, Iowa.

Lindenwood's Andrew Bradbury won his second consecutive title at 125 in the second overtime period over Cumberland College (Ky.) sophomore Delrico Choates. Bradbury trailed 6-2 in the first period, but tied up the match with 15 seconds left in the second period at 6-6. Bradbury was leading in the second overtime when the match was ended by a medical forfeit.

Stryder Davis of Montana State University-Northern successfully defended his 157 pound title with a 4-0 victory against Jake Dieffenbach of Lindenwood. Davis concludes the season with an impressive 41-1 record and earned the outstanding wrestler award. The Lights also had two other individuals crowned as champions. Bryan Luna captured the 133 pound title over Kyle Jahn of McKendree College (Ill.) and Jesse Juarez won the 184 crown with a 13-4 major decision over Joffree Lander of Embry-Riddle University (Ariz.).

Roger Miller of Lindenwood won his first national championship in the heavyweight class with a 2-1 decision over Chris Johnson of Missouri Valley; Miller finished third and second in the last two championships. Mike Rio rounded out the Lions' individual champions at 149 when he pinned William Penn University's (Iowa) Darren Cotton.

Missouri Valley finished second place in the team competition with 128.5 points. They were followed closely by Cumberland (Ky.) with 115.5 points, Montana State-Northern finished fourth with 111 points and Dana College (Neb.) rounded out the top five with 86 points.

The 2005 NAIA Coach of the Year Award was presented to Joe Parisi of Lindenwood, while Embry-Riddle University (Ariz.) was given the Team Sportsmanship Award. The Gorriaran Award was presented to Paul Collum of Missouri Valley for the most falls in the least amount of time. The top four finishers in each weight class earn all-America honors while the fifth through eighth place finishers receive honorable mention.
